

We build our power as mothers to ensure a livable climate for all children.

Why mothers?

Because we engage in our communities and we will do what it takes to protect the future for our children.

We empower all mothers to lead and win campaigns at the community and statewide level for:

- More clean energy;
- Less fossil fuel infrastructure;
- Fixing dirty gas leaks;
- Clean air and water;
- Our children's health and future.



We are young, but growing fast – as we must, to match the urgency of climate change. Our base includes over 23,000 supporters in nine states.. Our operating budget has grown from \$350,000 in 2014 to \$4.3M in 2019.



In Massachusetts, we secured landmark clean energy legislation at the state level in both 2016 and 2018 and persuaded the state's major utilities to commit to fixing the large-volume leaks along their gas pipelines that are responsible for 50% of the leaked gas within two years.

We continue to hold the line on fossil fuel construction - refusing to let their children -- or others' children -- bear the health and safety risks that the industry fails to acknowledge.

Mothers Out Front volunteers and allies were among the first on the scene to respond to the needs of Merrimack Valley families, who were unable to cook or bathe in the wake of the disaster.

In Fore River, Mothers Out Front continues to rally behind the local community and strengthen its call for environmental justice against the proposed compressor station. Mothers and caregivers have been central to keeping this dangerous project at bay.
