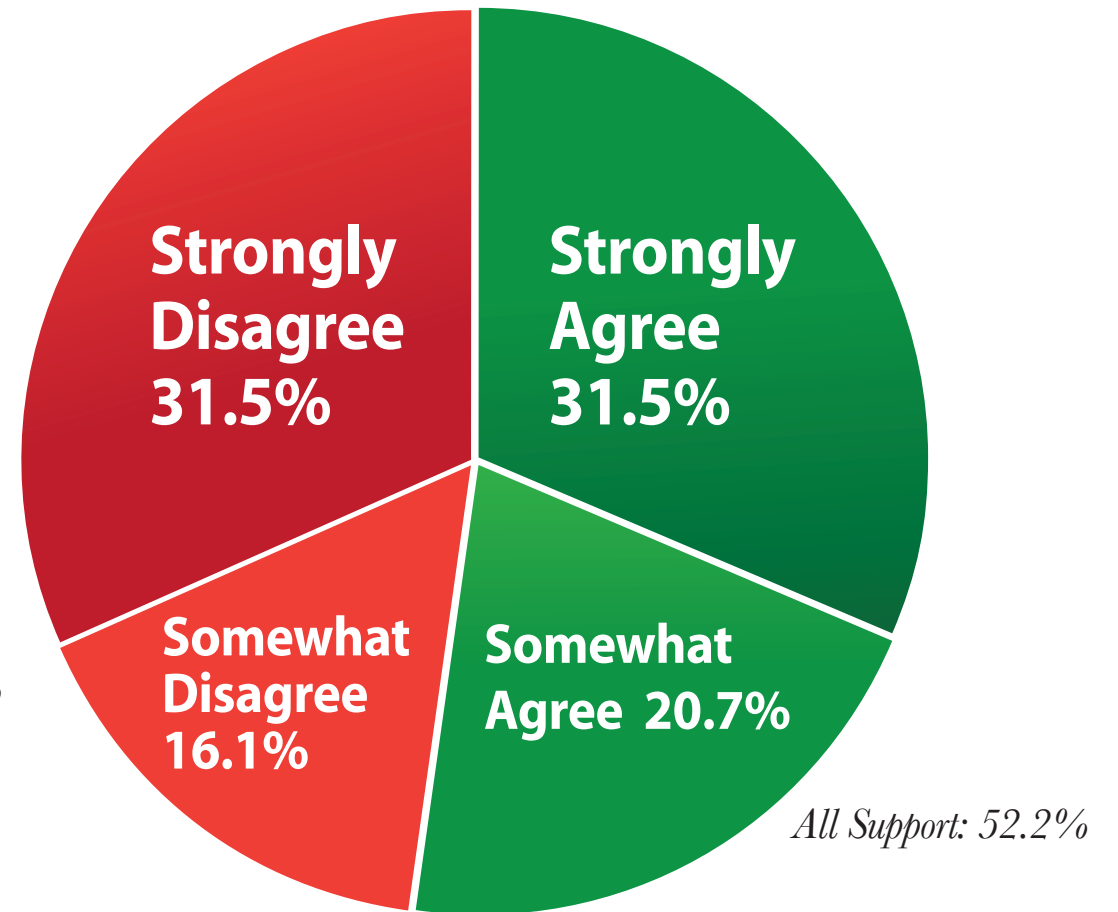


DROP DAYLIGHT SAVINGS + PST

If approved, this would place Alaska in the same time zone as Seattle for four months of the year, and one hour behind Seattle for the rest of the year. 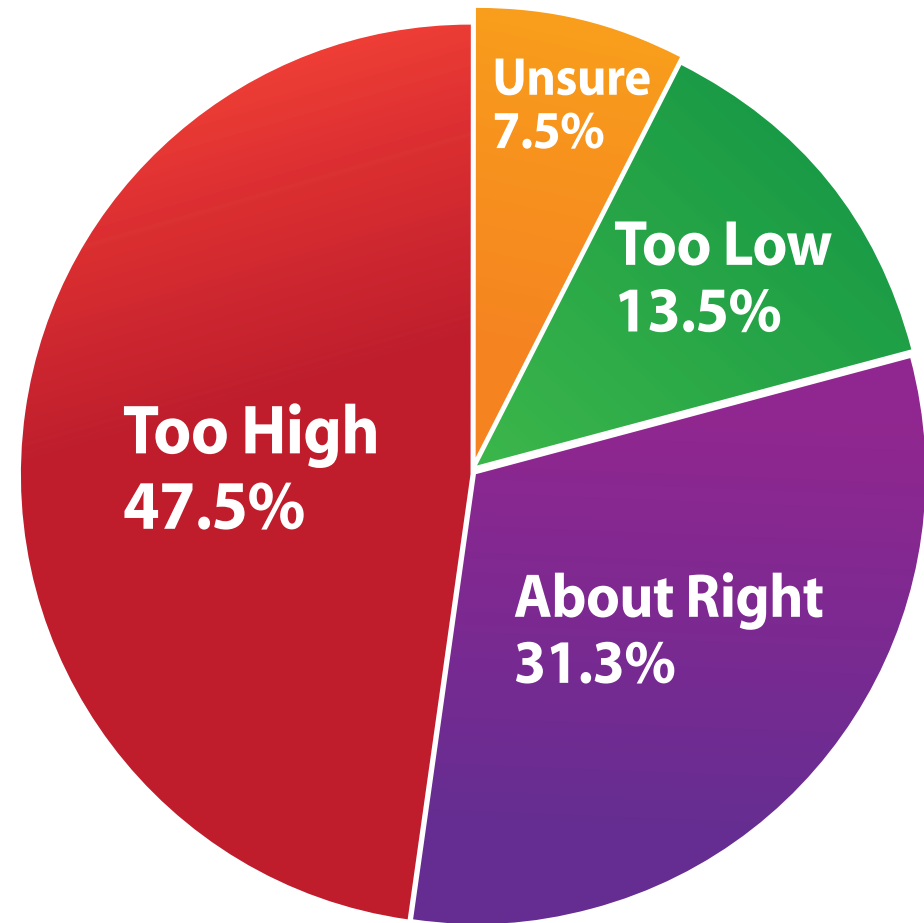


STATE SPENDING

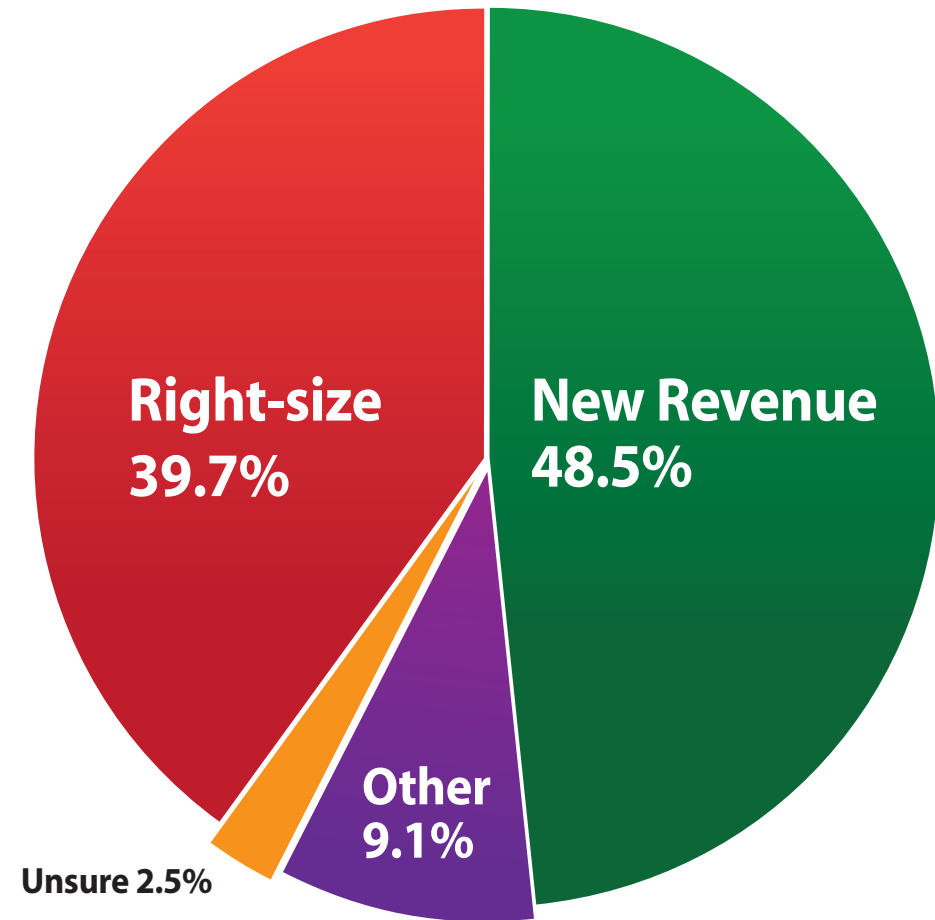


SIZE OF GOVERNMENT

- 4) *Neither/unsure*

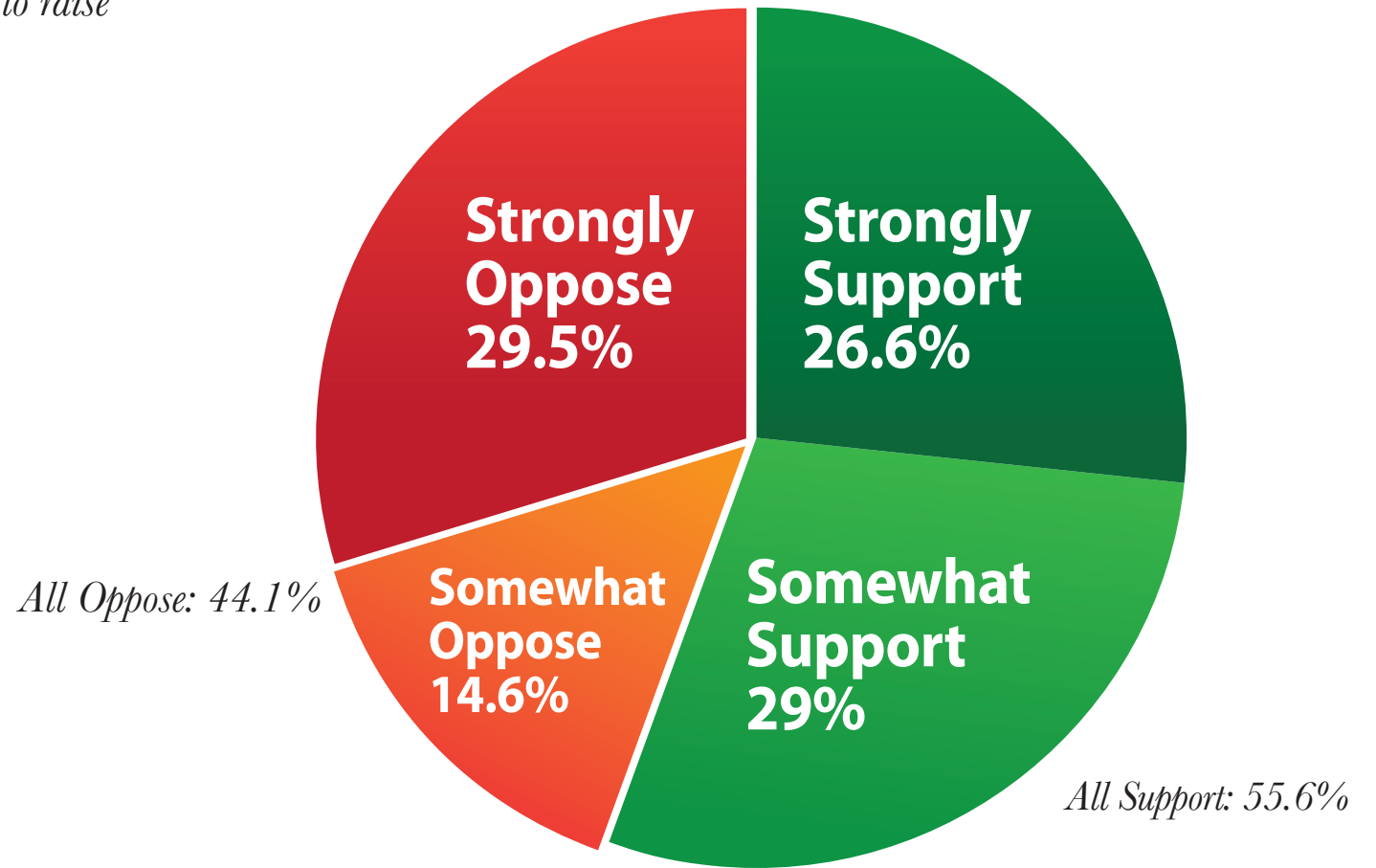


SALES TAX

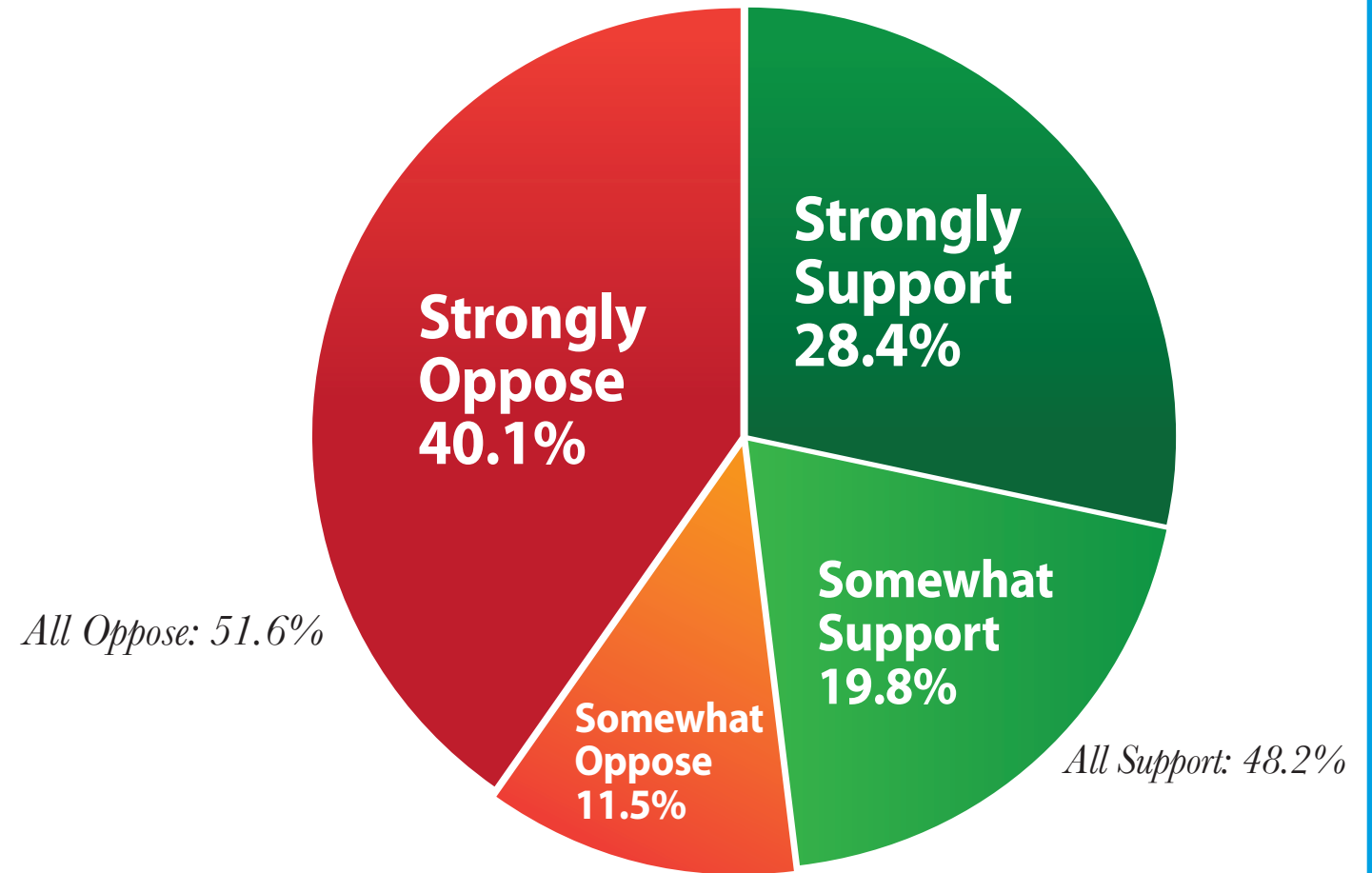


INCOME TAX

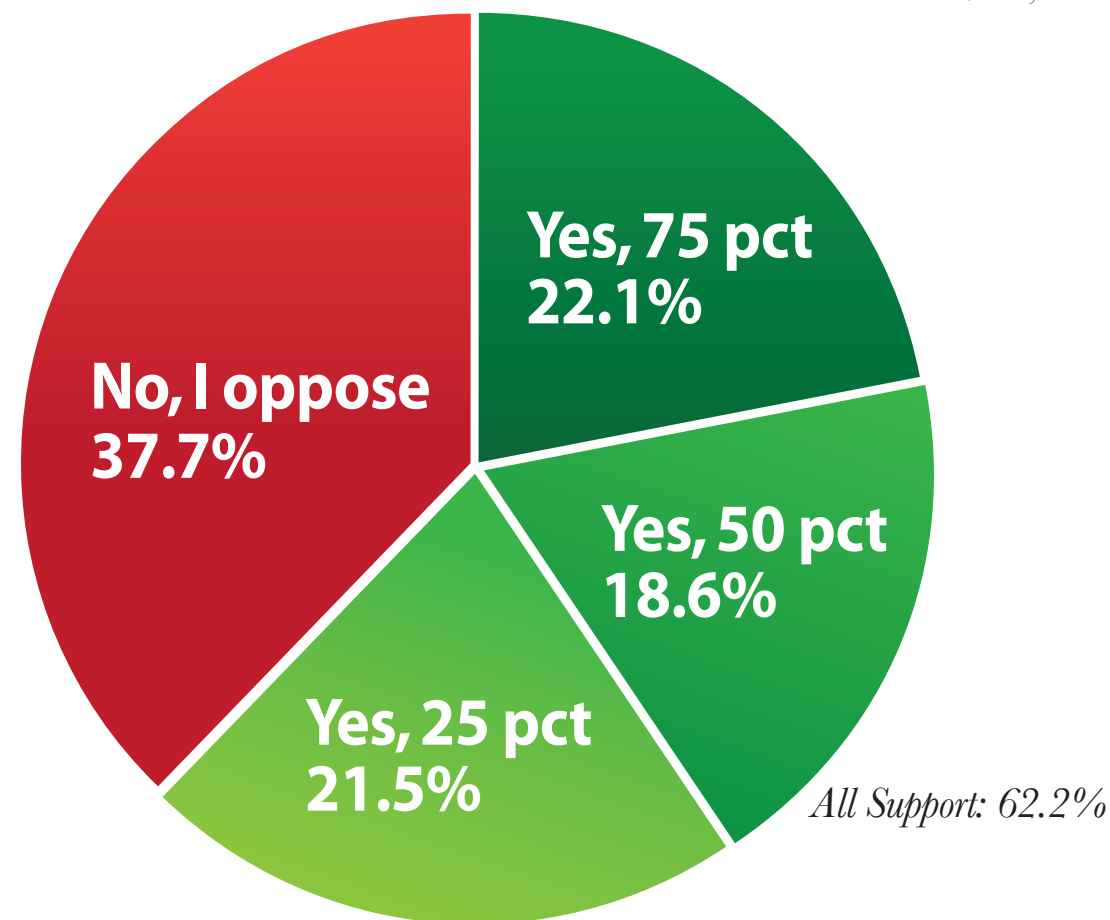

- 4) No, I oppose using Permanent Fund earnings for public education*

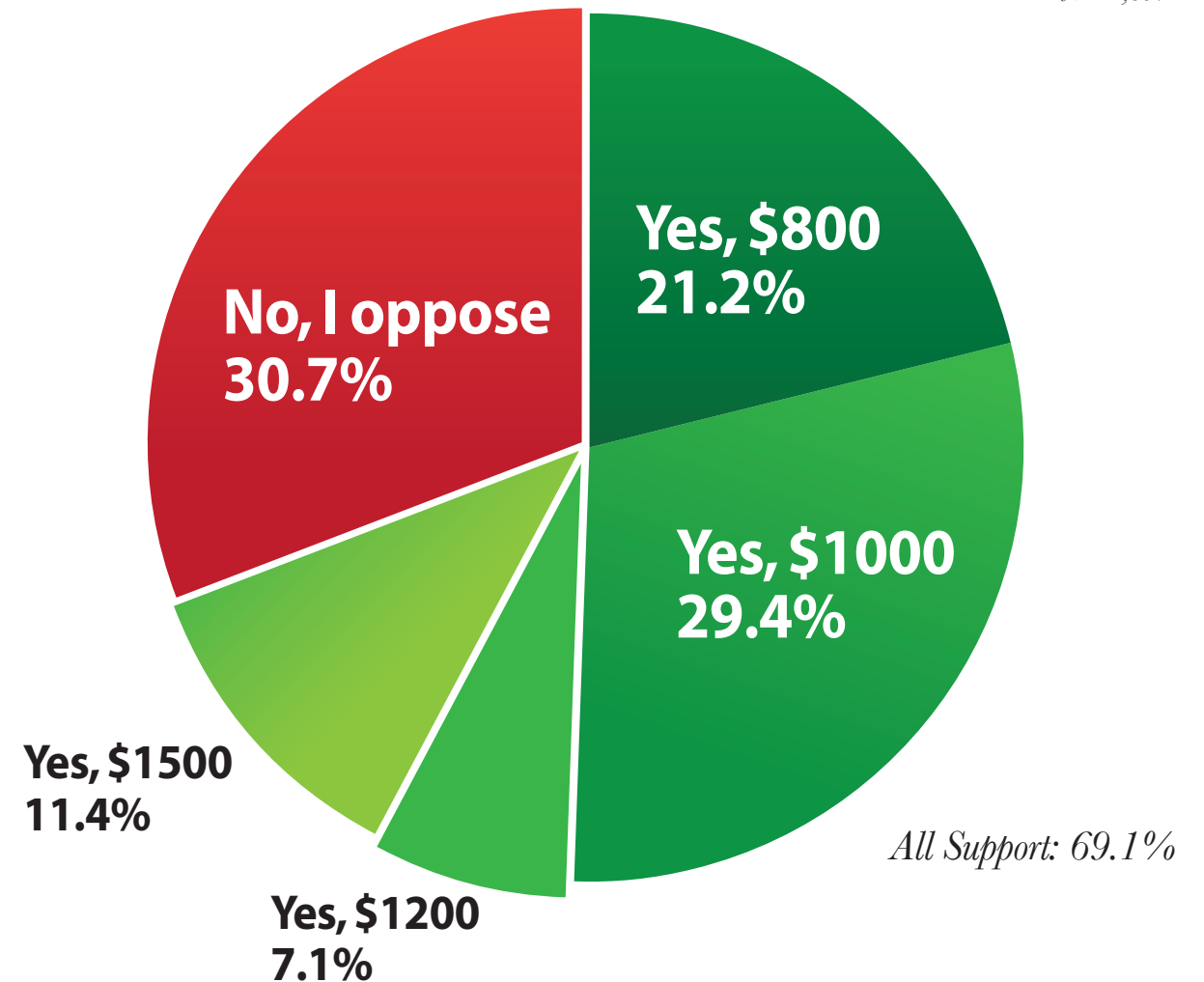


CAP THE PFD FOR GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICES

- 5) *No, I oppose capping the dividend*

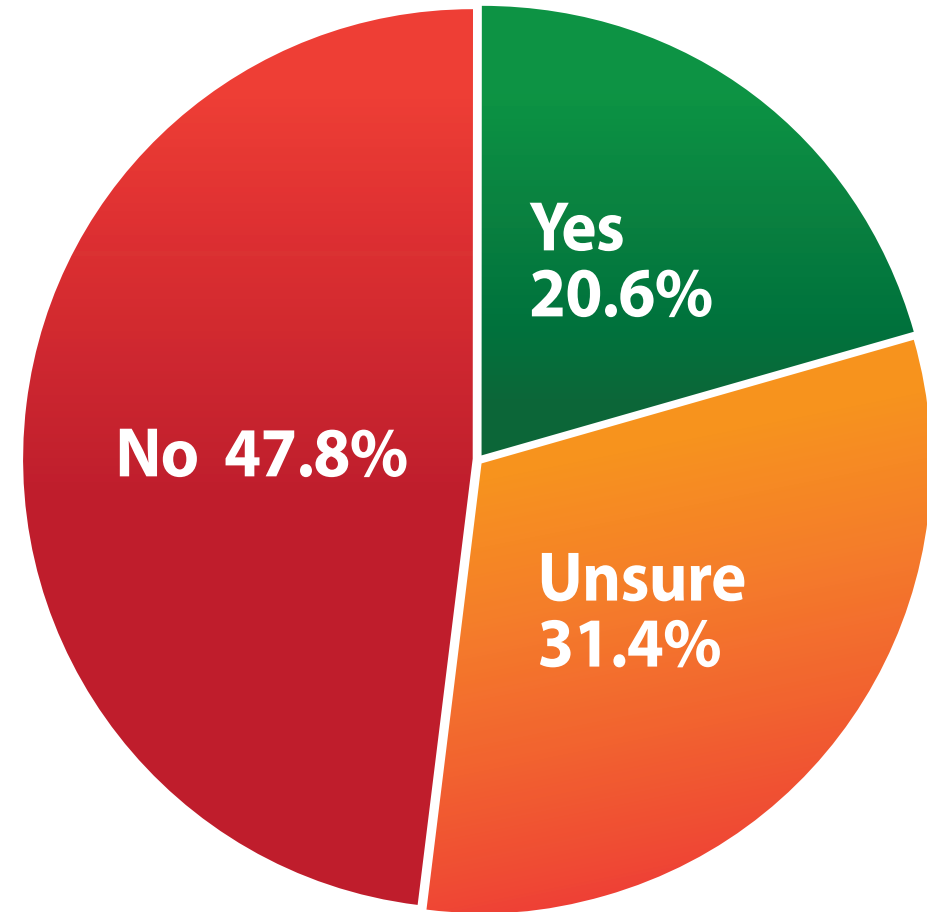


GO-IT-ALONE ON LNG GASLINE

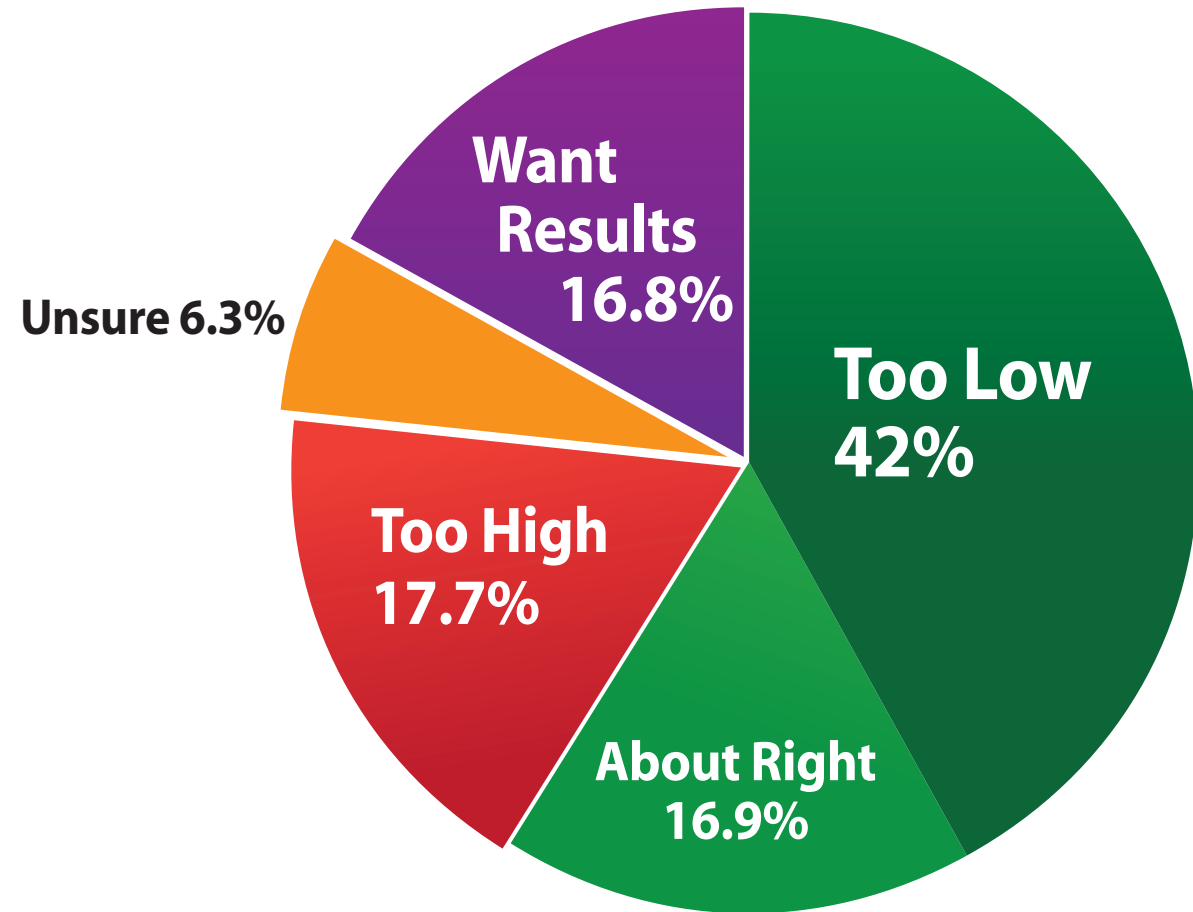


K-12 FUNDING

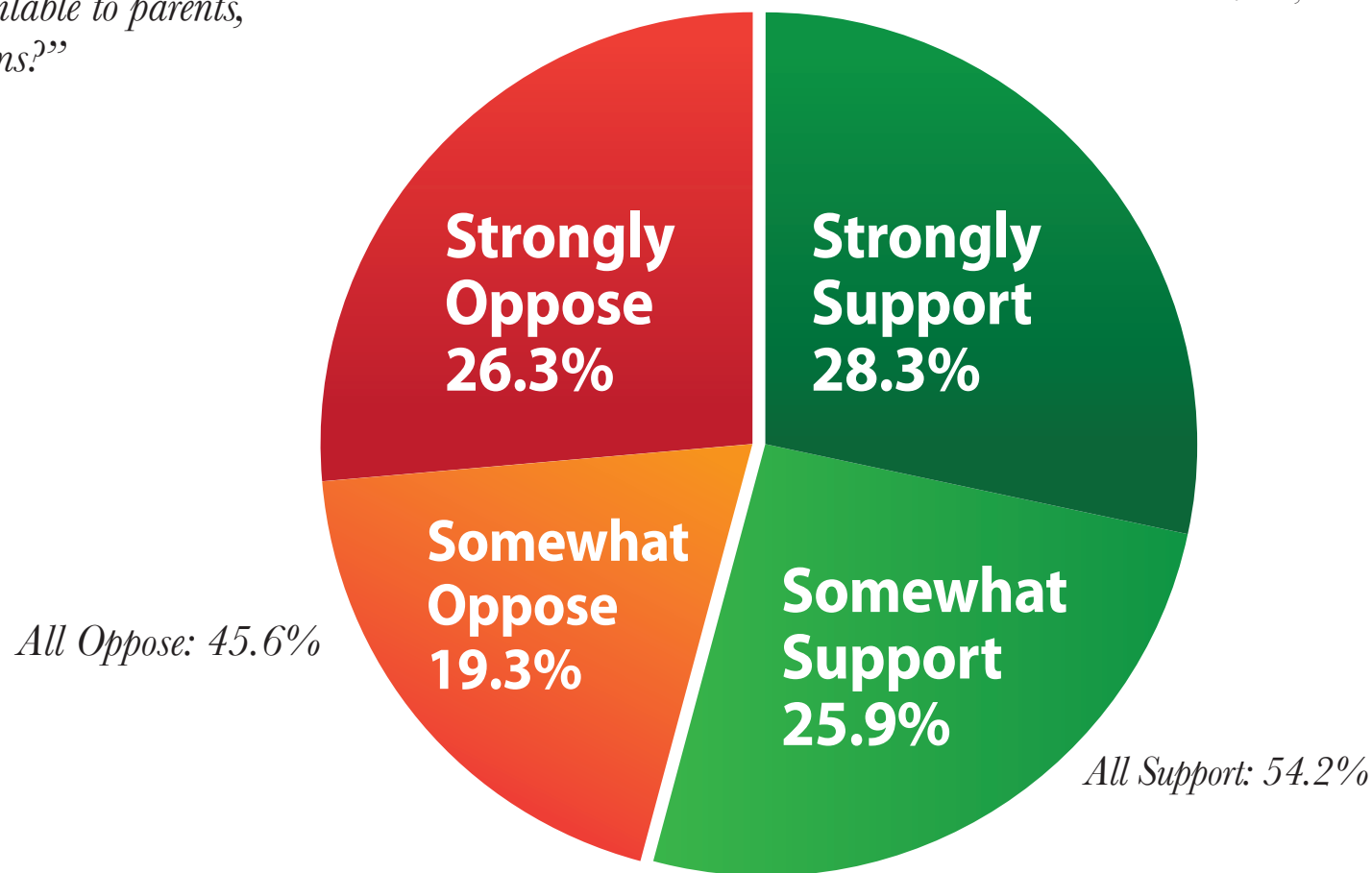


PARENTAL EDUCATION OPTIONS
