DeKalb High School *Money Smart Teen Scholarship*

2018 Money Smart Teen Essay Question

Please write a 2-page essay, double-spaced, explaining how to make an informed financial decision about which school to attend for your post-secondary plans (college or trade school). Share information you have collected and sources, your plan and necessary costs, your budget for living expenses in addition to your coursework and books, and how you will pay for the expenses. Be sure to include tips and resources for others who are college bound. A budget (page 3) should be included in addition to the 2-page essay.

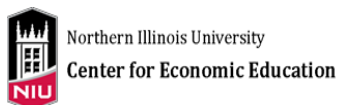
Guidelines

Candidates Must:

- Be a Senior High School Student with a minimum "C" average grade point
- Have knowledge of money management skills (decision-making related to spending and saving, investing, use of credit, etc.) appropriate for their age and grade level
- Be able to respond to questions from business leaders and media
- Be articulate – able to speak in front of large groups
- Live in DeKalb

To Apply

1. Student must write an essay (2-pages) on the assigned topic and include a budget in addition to the 2-page essay.
2. Essays must be typed on plain white paper, double-spaced using a 10 pt. Arial font. The Money Smart Teen Scholarship Application Form must be attached to the essay pages.
3. The essay must be the work of the student submitting the essay and free from spelling grammatical errors.
4. The application form must be signed by a parent/guardian and student.
