
**Re: Temporary Road Closure, Dromore Crescent, Sterling Street to Paisley Avenue, Friday, September 10, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for crane works.**

Please be advised that your application to temporarily close the above-mentioned roadway be approved, subject to the following conditions:

- a) That the city may revoke this temporary road closure at any time to gain access for emergency services.
- b) That no property owner or resident within the barricaded area be denied access to their property upon request.
- c) That all warning boards and detour signs manufactured and installed in advance of the closure by the City of Hamilton (or an approved third party) be at the expense of the applicant.
- d) That the applicant notify all property owners and tenants affected by the closure a minimum of 2 weeks in advance. The notice must be in a form acceptable to the Chief Road Official and contain a 24-hour contact name and telephone number.
- e) That a Traffic Control Plan be submitted in advance of the closure in a form acceptable to the Chief Road Official or designate. The plan must conform to "Ontario Traffic Manual Book 7 – Temporary Conditions" with all costs the responsibility of the applicant.
- f) That the applicant pay the required full road closure fee of \$1,519.90 made payable to "The City of Hamilton" prior to road closure.
- g) That the applicant provide proof of \$2,000,000 public liability insurance naming the City of Hamilton as an added insured party with a provision for cross liability, and holding the City of Hamilton harmless from all actions, causes of action, interests, claims, demands, costs, damages, expenses and loss.

- h) That the applicant ensure that clean-up operations be carried out immediately before the re-opening of the roads, to the satisfaction of the Chief Road Official at the expense of the applicant.
