

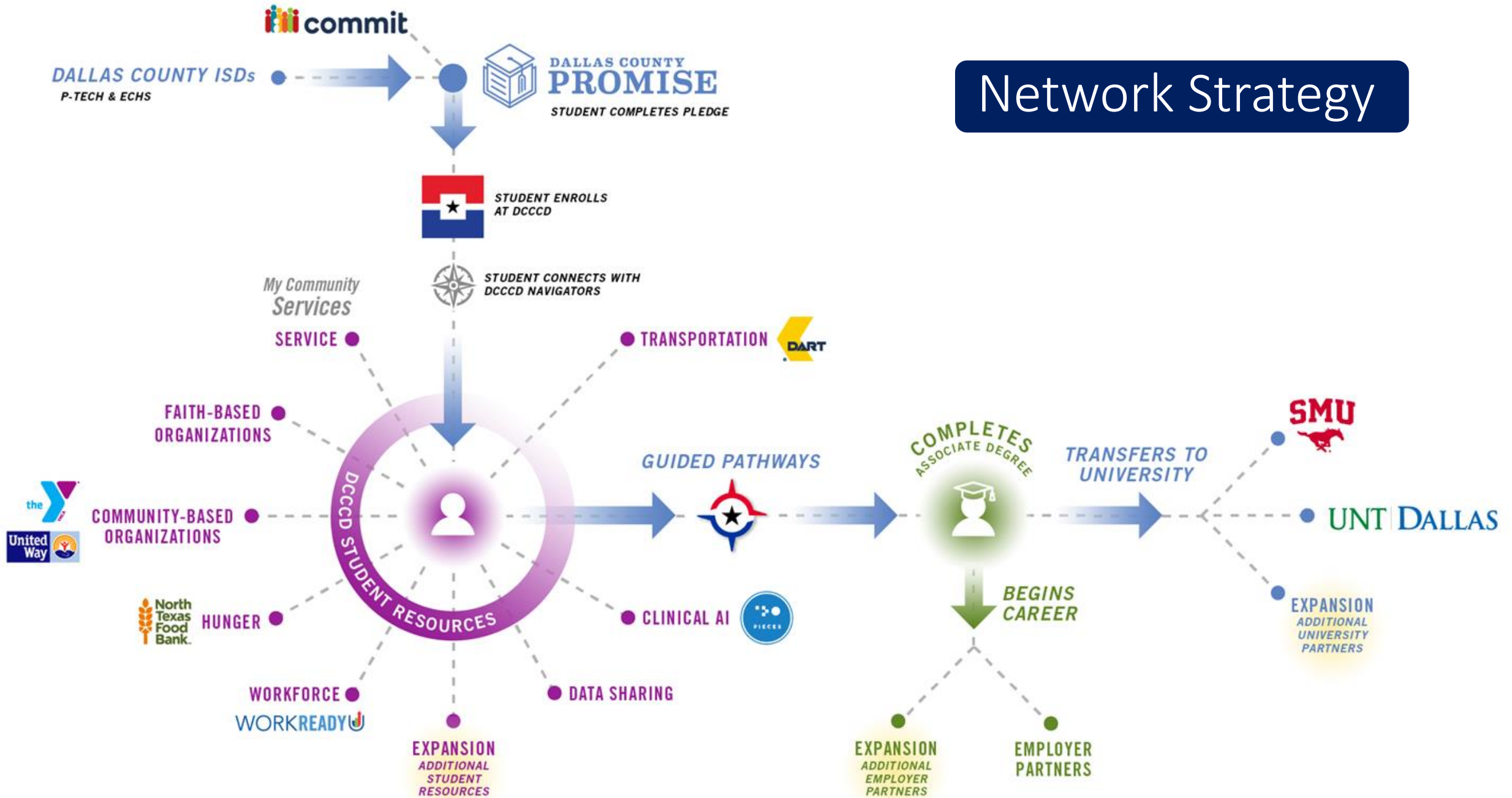

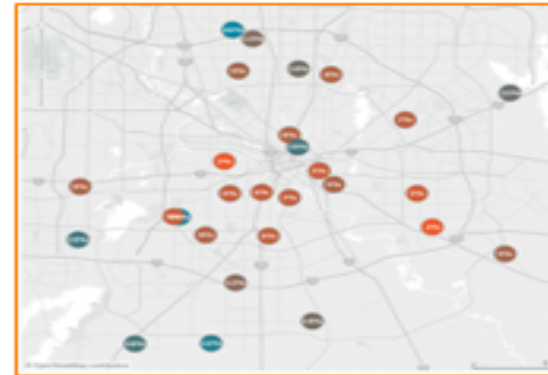
- Based on the TN Promise (All means All—regardless of income or GPA)

# COHORT 1 DEMONSTRATED SIGNIFICANT GAINS IN FINANCIAL AID COMPLETION AND COLLEGE ENROLLMENT

- 9,300 High School Seniors
- 80% Economically Disadvantaged
- 55% Hispanic / 35% Black / 10% White
- 11% Historical Six-Year College Completion
