Code of Conduct

Politically

Commit to the party's directives, standards and policies before everyone as well as on social media platforms and abide by its internal regulations

Respect other parties and do not offend any political opponent by words or actions.

Place the interests of the country and the citizen above all other considerations.

Steer clear of violence in any form or under any circumstances except in the

case of legitimate self-defense of oneself and one's property.

Acknowledge and respect constructive opposition and the right to disagree.

Vote, even if only to cast a blank ballot, because voting is a duty

and a sacred right.

Be accurate and credible while replying to any question regarding the party.

Do not abuse or misuse authority for personal ends.

Do not use public resources for personal or electoral purposes.

Acknowledge the democratic process and accept victory and defeat

in the same healthy competitive spirit.

Refer to the party's leadership and specialized personnel regarding ambiguous matters.

Respect allies and deal with them with honesty, sincerity and loyalty.



Legally

Respect the Constitution and all applicable laws and legal texts in the Republic of Lebanon.

Commit to pay taxes and fees of any kind.

Do not engage in drug dealing and trafficking.

Respect the judiciary and do not intervene in its decisions.

Assume responsibility for wrongdoings and violations, and do not evade it.

Do not use bribery of any kind to reach personal ends.

Personally

Prioritize the purchase of Lebanese products.

Apply the principle of citizenship over sectarianism.

Develop the sense of citizenship in your children.

Do not accept any preferential treatment (favoritism)-

Be honest and loyal in all aspects of life.

Use social media platforms in a thoughtful and decent manner.

Socially

Respect all citizens including their rights and privacy.

Respect public and private properties and do not violate them.

Do not commit any acts of harassment.

Respect all religions and beliefs.

Act in a civilized way in public; for example, do not litter streets, respect traffic signals, etc.

Deal fairly with people. Be modest, do not act with superiority, or use personal privileges to influence others.

Respect the environment, recycle, and avoid wasting energy and natural resources of any kind.

Show solidarity with others, based on the principle that the human value should be placed above all other considerations.

Professionally

Maintain professional confidentiality and do not leak any sensitive information.

Be honest and avoid any conflict of interests.

Do not abuse your position to make personal, material or moral profits.

Work conscientiously and fulfill the tasks entrusted you to the fullest extent.

Respect the institution's internal regulations and the Labor Law.

Always be ready to help colleagues and give them advice and guidance.
