
Joint governance model - Ngāi Tahu Takiwā

Councils and Ngāi Tahu have equal representation on a Joint Governance Group (JGG). The JGG provides single consolidated forum representing key stakeholders.

- Water entity is a statutory entity and requires legislation.
- Has a Board but does not need to be a company corporate (eg company) and non-corporate (eg body corporate) structures are possible.
- Owners are the Canterbury councils and Ngãi Tahu, who are responsible for appointing representatives to the JGG.
- JGG responsible for appointing the water entity Board. May have a specific Ngãi Tahu appointed Board seat.
- . JGG develops a LoE to communicate strategic direction, spatial planning and prioritisation (which the water entity must have regard to when preparing their Sol).
- Has a constitution that sets key strategic objectives for the water entity; accountability and reporting requirements; how directors are appointed and removed, their powers and delegations; and parameters around ownership.
- The Board appoints the Chief Executive, Chief Executive appoints management.
- Sol provided to the JGG for comment (rather than approval).
- Pricing methodology and price decision making by management with approval by the Board (no owner approvals).
- Operational and financial decision making undertaken by management, with major decisions requiring Board approval (no owner approvals).
- · Water entity is subject to performance monitoring:
 - Taumata Arowai for drinking water;
 - Crown for economic regulation; and
 - Regional Authorities for environmental.
- Elect councillors, provide feedback on consultation and pay rates (noting that as owners councils have limited direct control).
 - An Advisory Group provides advice to the Board on local issues and considerations including in relation to quality, level of service and environmental impacts, as well providing a forum for localised investment prioritisation to be considered.
 - A Community Forum may also be required to provide direct community input.
