# How to Read These Tables

- **UNWEIGHTED COUNT (UC):** Also called Column n. This refers to the number of people who fall into each category.

The unweighted base generally only appears as the last row of figures.

- **PERCENTAGE:** These are vertical percentages. These can be interpreted in the following manner. “x% of COLUMN HEADING responded to the question with ROW HEADING”.
