The NCSA Board urges Neighborhood Councils to call for LADWP to shift its energy generation portfolio to 100% renewable energy by 2030 and refrain from further investment in its fossil fuel infrastructure—lofty and impactful goals.

The timeline for this issue is immediate, as LADWP is setting their Integrated Resource Plan right now.
