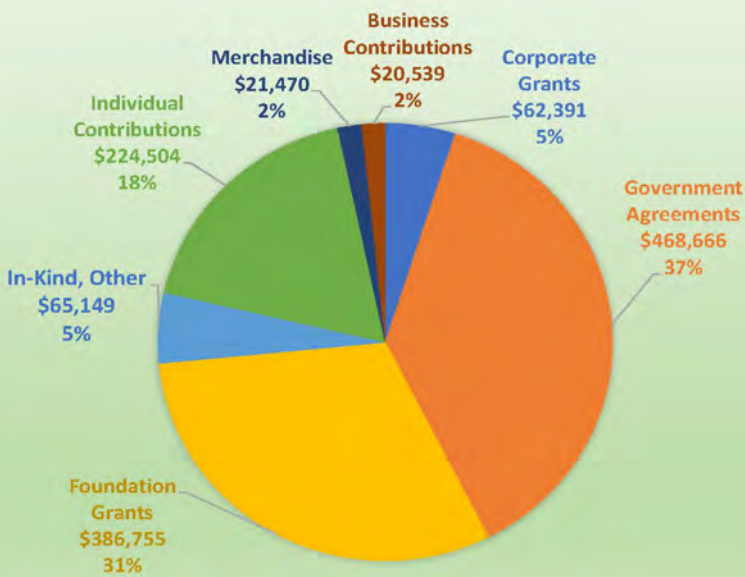


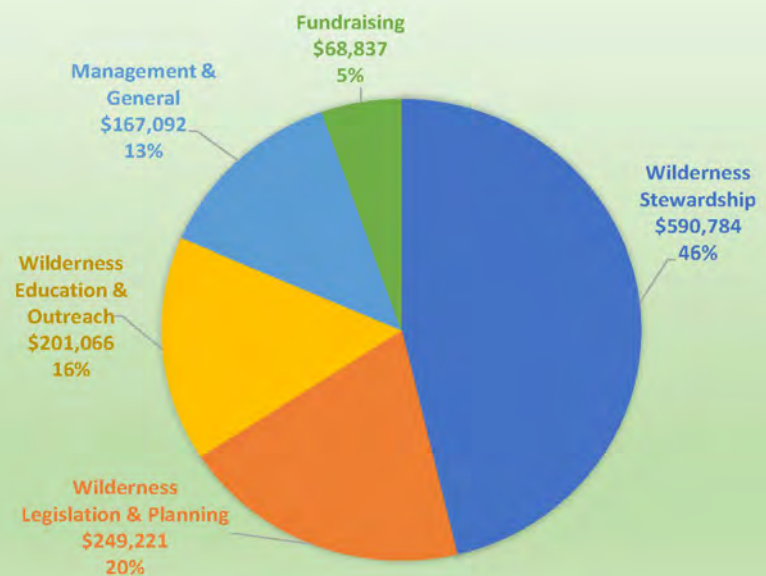

2019 Program Accomplishments

Volunteer Wilderness Stewardship Program

In partnership with the land management agencies, Friends' stewardship program worked on the ground with volunteers to clean up, monitor and heal wildlands and improve wildlife habitat and recreational trail access. In 2019, 567 volunteers completed 58 restoration and monitoring projects giving back a total of \$233,300 of in-kind volunteer service. Volunteers monitored springs, planted seedlings for fire restoration, pulled invasive weeds, and installed signs. Our trail crews maintained 82 miles of trail removing 364 downed trees. Our Sheldon crew removed 112 miles of barbed wire fence and 16.5 tons of waste metal from the Refuge wildlands.



Wilderness Legislation and Planning Program

In 2019, we worked with Washoe and Clark Counties on public lands legislation that would include wilderness designations. We attended public meetings and fought against military takeover efforts on proposed wilderness in the Desert National Wildlife Refuge. We testified at and were successful with the Nevada State Legislature passing resolutions opposing additional military expansion. We have read, analyzed and provided comments on many public land proposals that could affect Nevada wildlands.

Wilderness Education and Outreach Program

In 2019, we signed up volunteers at 45 outreach events and discussed Nevada's wilderness and why it is important. We designed and printed two newsletters, produced the 2020 Wild Nevada calendar, sent monthly E-newsletters and numerous alerts and event invitations to inform members about what was happening with wilderness in Nevada. We hosted the popular Wild and Scenic Film Festival in Las Vegas and the Wild Nevada Artown Show in Reno. We produced a trail map and brochure for the Toiyabe Crest Trail.
