**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF COMPREHENSIVE
FEDERAL PUBLIC LANDS LEGISLATION**

WHEREAS, comprehensive public lands legislation addressing recreation, economic development, and conservation has provided important benefits to counties across Nevada, and can provide important benefits to Washoe County; and

WHEREAS, Washoe County is expected to add over 100,000 new residents by 2030, and many of these new families will require schools; and

WHEREAS, comprehensive public lands legislation would assist the Washoe County School District with meeting the future education needs of our county by making available appropriate Federal lands for school construction sites; and

WHEREAS, Congress has passed similar legislation which is currently providing important benefits in Lincoln, Clark, White Pine, Lyon, and Humboldt counties; and

WHEREAS, comprehensive public lands legislation will advance economic development, recreation, and conservation interests, and will receive the support of diverse stakeholders within Washoe County.




