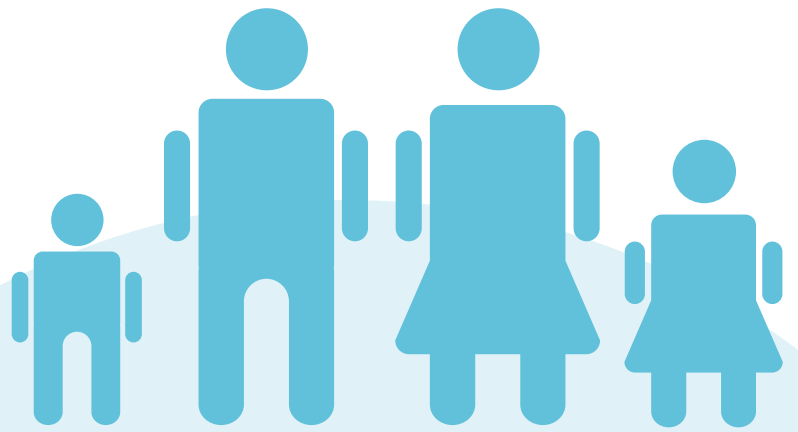

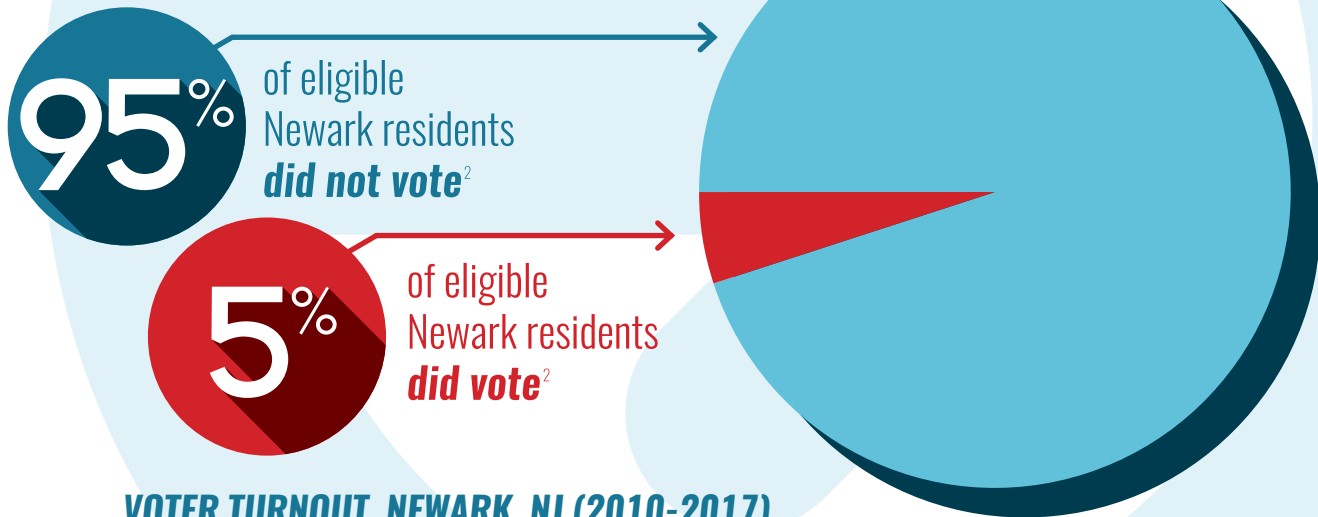

Local school boards play a critical role in helping improve student achievement across the education system. Yet voter participation in school board elections remains low.

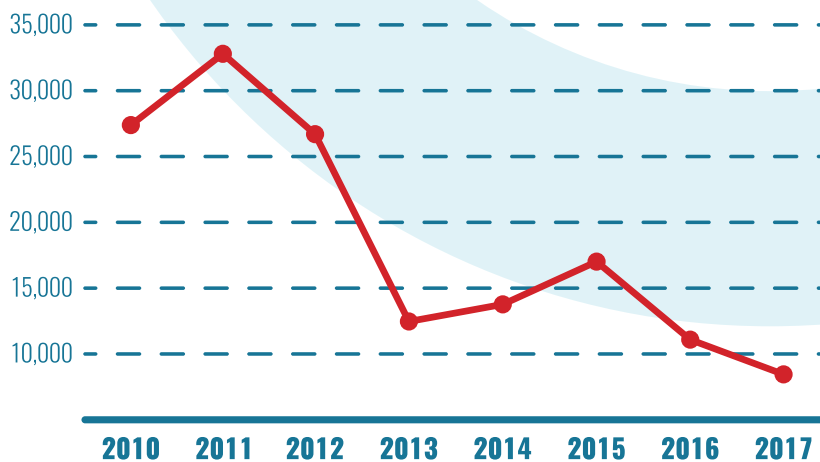
