Reflecting on Charlottesville

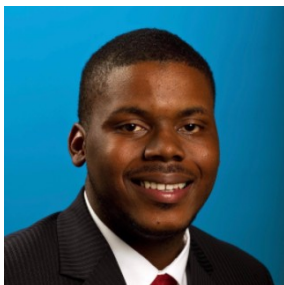
