Started the first Youth Market in the community providing young people with jobs, providing them with real alternatives to incarceration and bring fresh fruits and vegetables to residents with an awareness of healthy choices and eating habits.
What are the greatest strengths and struggles of your council district?	Real quality, affordable housing is a big issue in the district, from property tax issues in Crown Heights to the rising forecloses in Bedford Stuyvesant many of the constituency fear being pushed out of their homes.
