

Membership policy

1. Terms and conditions

By submitting an application for membership of the National Health Action Party (“NHA Party”), you agree to the following statement:

“I agree to abide by the rules and constitution of the National Health Action Party. I will adhere to the Code of Conduct. If registering as a Full Member, I confirm I am aged 14 years or over, I am a subject or resident of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or a citizen of Eire and I am not a member of any other political party unless affiliated with the NHA Party.”

Party members shall be required to fulfil the criteria required by law for political donors in the UK, and shall forfeit their membership if they become unable to fulfil those criteria.

For the purposes of the above terms and conditions, the party’s rules and constitution shall be considered to include the party policy documents. These are created, maintained and published by the National Executive Committee (“NEC”) in accordance with the party constitution, and include:

- a) the Conflict of Interests Policy,
- b) the Election Candidates Policy,
- c) the Membership Policy,
- d) the Complaints Policy,
- e) the NEC Regulations,
- f) the Party Financial Scheme,
- g) the Membership Subscription Rates,
- h) the Code of Conduct.

2. Responsibilities to members

The NHA Party will take reasonable steps to support the involvement of members in relevant party meetings, in accordance with the party constitution and relevant legislature. The NHA Party will manage member’s data according to the party’s Privacy Policy, in accordance with relevant data protection laws.

3. Right to refuse or terminate membership

The NHA Party reserves the right to refuse any application for membership which, in the opinion of the NEC, based on reasonable evidence, would be contrary to the interests of the Party. The NHA Party is not required to give the reason for such a refusal. In cases where an application is processed automatically, the NHA Party reserves the right to retrospectively refuse the application upon discovery of said application. The NHA Party reserves the right to suspend and/or terminate an individual’s membership subject to the disciplinary processes detailed in the party constitution and rules.
