Deadline: Tuesday, November 30, 2021

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

An application is considered **complete** only if it is accompanied by the following documents, which **must be submitted together with this Guidelines sheet.**

 Sign this Educational Scholarship Guideline sheet and Submit ALONG WITH a completed Educational Scholarship Program Application Form.

2. Letter of Recommendation

- Each application shall include one (1) letter of recommendation, which must be attached or sent within the specified time frame. Letter shall be from someone <u>other than</u> a family member who has known you for at least two (2) years and/or from someone who has been influential to your success (e.g. faculty member, counselor, employer, minister, etc.)
- The letter must address the relationship to the applicant, length of time acquainted with applicant, applicant strengths and weaknesses and applicant's goals. Examples which elaborate on the applicant's commitment to the community, must also be addressed.

3. Essays

- Each application must include one (1) essay, addressing one of the following topics and must not exceed two (2) pages.
 - TOPIC #1: The first essay shall be a personal narrative addressing the following:
 - Describe your academic and professional goals, including contributions to your community.

TOPIC #2: Address one of the following topics (choose one only):

- The importance or value of obtaining a higher education
- The potential impacts or influences of a growing Latino population in relation to your field of interest
- The specific challenges faced by Latinas in pursuit of higher education

4. Copy of one of the following:

- Financial Aid Notification Letter
- Parents (or Self) 2019 or 2020 Income Tax Return
- Student Aid Report
- 5. **Unofficial** College/University Transcript(s) must be included with all application materials.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- · Be a student residing in Southern California
- · Pursue an undergraduate or graduate degree
- In need of educational financial assistance
- Be a student in good standing with at least a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Participate in some form of community service
- Must be at least a college or university Freshman status
- · Attending or planning to attend any accredited college or university in the USA
