

HB 1368 requires that a political contribution by a limited liability company be allocated to members for purposes of determining whether a member has exceeded the contribution limits.

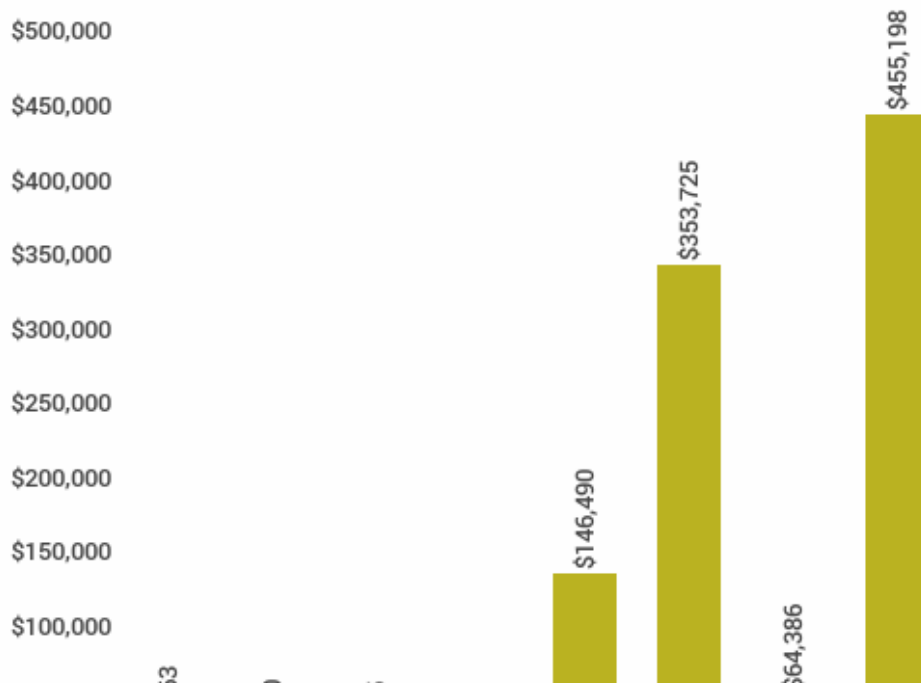

A bill that would close a [loophole that lets business owners](#) make multiple campaign contributions to a single candidate.

- . At issue is something known as the LLC loophole – with LLC standing for limited liabilities company.
- . Under current law, individuals who control multiple LLCs can exceed legal campaign contribution limits to a single candidate by spreading their checks across their different businesses.

- . The current campaign limit is 7,000 dollars per donor, per candidate.
- . LLC Loophole is used by both parties.
