

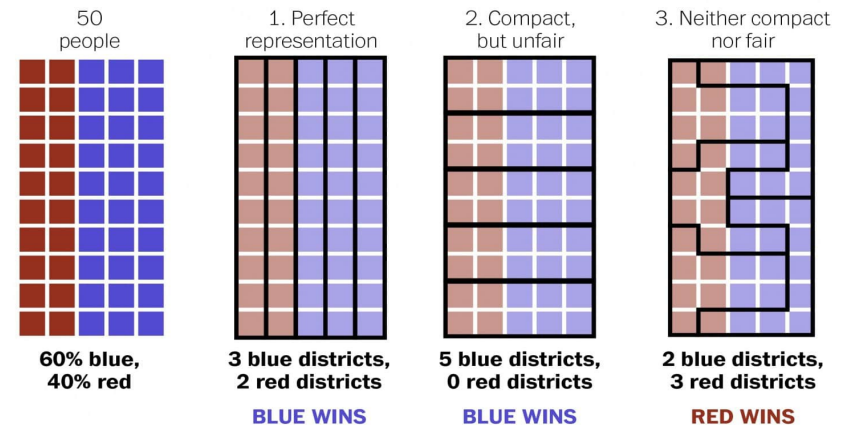
Your Vote Should Matter!

Gerrymandering is drawing voting districts to benefit a party or candidate – it's cheating!

- Redistricting should be fair to all parties, and especially the voters
- Gerrymandering redraws the line so that even if you don't have the most votes, you win.
- Gerrymandering makes it so your vote doesn't matter by “packing” one party into a district so that party wins or loses EVERY TIME!
- Our last redistricting gerrymandered dozens of voting districts around the state and was done behind closed doors.
- Redistricting should be done in public meetings – full transparency!
