The Safer Communities Fund Round 5: Early Intervention grants provides state and territory peak Police Citizens' Youth Clubs, Bluelight organisations and Youth Off the Streets with grants of up to \$3 million.

The grants aim to deliver local crime prevention activities that address anti-social behaviour and/or racial or religious intolerance by at-risk marginalised youth.

To be eligible you must:

- be a legal entity
- have an Australian Business Number (ABN) or an Australian Company Number (ACN).

Only projects identified by the Australian Government will be considered for funding under the CDG Programme.

Celebrate Together Grants

The Celebrate Together Grants provide one-off funding to eligible multicultural organisations to host festivals and events that celebrate cultural diversity.

There are two categories of grants under the Celebrate Together Grants:

Large Grants from \$5001 to \$30 000 are available to eligible multicultural organisations for festivals and events to be delivered within 12 months, commencing in July 2020. There are matched funding requirements for applicants requesting Large Grants. Large Grants applications that are not successful may also be considered for Small Grants.

Small Grants are valued up to \$5000. The first round will be for events held between 1 July 2020 and 31 December 2020 and the second round will be for events held between 1 January 2021 and 30 June 2021.

- Applications for Large Grants and Small Grants (Round 1) are **now open**.
- Applications for Small Grants (Round 2) will open on 3 August 2020 and close on 30 September 2020 at 5pm.

Stronger Together Grants (Coming Soon)

The Stronger Together Grants support South Australian families and communities from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds to build resilience and become a part of a strong and vibrant South Australian community.

The grants provide one-off funding to eligible multicultural organisations to develop projects that address priority needs and issues and improve outcomes for culturally and linguistically diverse communities.

The grants will assist multicultural organisations to develop and deliver projects over two years that strengthen families and communities and improve their access to better social and economic opportunities.

Applications will be open again in **late 2020** for projects that will be delivered in 2021-23.
