



Election Day is Tuesday, November 6, 2018

In 2018, the race for New Jersey's 11th congressional district is competitive for the first time in over two decades, and the **difference between our two candidates could not be greater.**

NJ 11th for Change enthusiastically endorses Mikie Sherrill, who best reflects our district's values of fairness, compassion, inclusivity, and a decent quality of life for all. Here's where the candidates stand on important issues:

Mikie Sherrill

Mikie Sherrill kept our country secure for **9 years** as a Navy Officer and pilot; now she pledges to work to keep our families, communities and our planet secure in Congress by defending **healthcare, women's rights, gun safety, environmental protections, tax fairness, and all our civil rights.**

- **Women's rights and healthcare:** "The federal government should have no say on when, how, and with whom women decide to start or grow a family." Will protect women's access to abortion and expand access to birth control. **Endorsed by Planned Parenthood and Emily's List.**
- Promotes **gun safety:** Universal background checks, keep guns away from domestic abusers, and terrorists on the No-Fly list, federal assault weapons ban, limits on large capacity magazines. **Endorsed by Giffords and Brady Campaign.**
- **Healthcare:** "Should be a right." Protect Affordable Care Act (ACA), including protections for people with pre-existing conditions; make sure every American has access to affordable healthcare coverage.

Jay Webber

Jay Webber, a career politician, is one of the most extreme right in Trenton. For **9 years**, has done all he can to **strip away the rights of women and LGBTQ people, cut healthcare, kill environmental reform, and put the interests of companies over people.**

- Proudly declares that he has worked his "entire adult life" to **ban abortions**; Voted **against** funding for Planned Parenthood and expanding access to contraception in NJ. He was one of 2 legislators to vote NO on pay equity this spring. **Endorsed by NJ Right to Life PAC.**
- **Against** gun safety measures including universal background checks and other reasonable safeguards. Voted against removing guns from domestic abusers, 93% NRA rating (2017).
- **"Committed to repealing Obama-Care"** (the Affordable Care Act). Voted **against** NJ Health Benefit Exchange and against increase in healthcare options for veterans.

- **Opposed the GOP Tax law** that eliminates many of our State and Local Tax (SALT) deductions; defends Social Security and Medicare.
- **Climate change:** Is “an economic and national security issue.” Protect the NJ coast from drilling, champion of renewable energy projects to create jobs. **Endorsed by New Jersey Sierra Club.**
- Clear about the **moral imperative to reunite separated immigrant families** and to treat all people with dignity and respect. She attended the Keep Families Together rally in Newark to show support.
- **Civil rights:** Defends Marriage Equality and Transgender Service in the Military
- **Interaction with constituents:** Commits to holding Town Halls and open office visits. Throughout her campaign, has actively made herself available to talk to and listen to constituents. Will not censor opposing opinions on social media.

Jay Webber *(continued)*

- **Supports the GOP tax law** that dismantled parts of the ACA, and lays the foundation for gutting Social Security and Medicare.
- Voted **against** expanding green jobs and clean energy incentives including tax credits for homeowners installing solar panels. 29% rating from NJ League of Conservation Voters environmental scorecard (2017).
- Silent on family separation, abstained from a vote condemning the family separations, though has publicly defended ICE.
- Voted **against** Marriage Equality and **against** ban on quack “conversion therapy” for gay NJ teens.
- Blocks constituents with opposing views on social media. Failed to participate in bipartisan March for Our Lives forum with other NJ 11 congressional candidates. Voted against numerous measures designed to make it easier for people to vote and register to vote.
