

7 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE RESCISSION OF DACA

1

• INITIAL DACA APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 WILL BE CONSIDERED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS AND PROCESSED AS USUAL.

2

• NO NEW INITIAL APPLICATIONS. ALL INITIAL DACA APPLICATIONS DATED SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 AND AFTERWARDS WILL BE REJECTED.

• DACA AUTHORIZATIONS THAT HAVE BEEN ISSUED ALREADY WILL NOT BE REVOKED. WORK AUTHORIZATIONS ARE VALID UNTIL THE EXPIRATION DATE LISTED ON THE CARD.

4

• ANY DACA AUTHORIZATIONS THAT WILL EXPIRE BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 5, 2017 AND MARCH 5, 2018 CAN BE RENEWED AS LONG AS THE RENEWAL IS SUBMITTED BY OCTOBER 5, 2017.

• ANY ADVANCE PAROLE REQUEST THAT HAS ALREADY BEEN APPROVED IS STILL VALID. (BUT IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED TO TRAVEL OUTSIDE THE U.S. AT THIS TIME.)

6

• NO NEW ADVANCE PAROLE APPLICATIONS WILL BE PROCESSED, ALL PENDING APPLICATIONS WILL BE ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED AND THE FEES REFUNDED.

7

• DHS STILL MAINTAINS THE DISCRETIONARY AUTHORITY TO DO WHATEVER IT WANTS TO.
