I write in response to your letter dated 4th February 2019 in regards to the NSWBC key pillars.

The Pillars

We strongly agree and support **ALL** of the 5 pillars that the NSWBC have put forward. We would go further on some of them including:

**Pillar 1/** Payroll Tax - we would prefer to see it scrapped, or the minimum thresh hold to be raised to 2 million and or Superannuation to be removed from the calculation.

**Pillar 4/** Improving delivery of major infrastructure - we believe that provisions must be made for the impacts on existing small businesses when major state significant projects take place. They must be considered and suitably mitigated against **BEFORE** they are destroyed.

We believe that The Small Business Party is unique in its political base as we are not beholden to any party and exist only for the advocacy of Small Business, our families and communities. We know that the NSWBC has been advocating for years and do not deny this, but it has become obvious to many small businesses that we need a seat at the table in parliament - both state and federal in order to achieve true reform. This would complement the work that the chamber does, not compete with it.

Just as the unions have direct representation in the Labor Party, it is time for small business to have the same.
