- have authorised payment of a levy in writing, as set out in Rule Q.13; and
- have authorised payment of Chifley Forum membership, as set out on page 5

5. At all times to conduct myself in Local Government public office in the best interests and solidarity of the Party.
6. To support the Party by communicating on a regular basis with the membership of the Party and wherever possible to support Party activities and events of which I am informed.
7. If appointed to the Legislative Council of NSW or to the Senate, I will report to the Administrative Committee according to the timeline set out in Rule D.13.

I undertake to resign from any position or office that would make me ineligible to hold the elected office for which I am nominating in a timely and practical manner as required by the relevant legislation or as directed by the General Secretary.
