



**New South Wales Society of Labor Lawyers  
Proposed Special Resolutions for the 2017 Annual General Meeting**

The following special resolutions have been proposed for the 2017 AGM:

**1. Online membership application forms**

Replace Clause 4(1)(a) with:

*must be made by a member of the Society in writing in the form set out in Appendix 1 to this constitution, or in a form otherwise specified by the secretary, and*

The reasons for the constitutional amendment are as follows:

*The amendment to this section simply formalises the use of online membership forms for membership nominations, as has been standard practice for some time. The prescribed use of a paper membership form is out of step with the modern methods employed by the Society.*

**2. Typographical Corrections**

At Clause 9(3) replace:

*A person is deemed to be unfinancial and ineligible to hold an office in the Society or to vote at a general meeting if the person fails to pay the annual membership fee under clause 8(2).*

With:

*A person is deemed to be unfinancial and ineligible to hold an office in the Society or to vote at a general meeting if the person fails to pay the annual membership fee under clause 9(2).*

At Clause 10 replace:

*The liability of a member of the Society to contribute towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the Society or the costs, charges and expenses of the winding up of the Society is limited to the amount, if any, unpaid by the member in respect of membership of the Society as required by clause 8.*

With:

*The liability of a member of the Society to contribute towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the Society or the costs, charges and expenses of the winding up of the Society is limited to the amount, if any, unpaid by the member in respect of membership of the Society as required by clause 9.*

The reasons for the above constitutional amendments are as follows:

*The amendments fix minor typographical errors in the constitution.*
