NUS Appalled by brutality at protest

The National Union of Students today are concerned by the actions of police who pepper sprayed students. Students were demonstrating an event at which the Minister for education Christopher Pyne was attending.

NUS President Rose Steele said ‘The force used today is deeply disconcerting. Students have the right to peacefully protest’

Students came together to protest this event as the legislation to deregulate university fees has been debated this week in parliament.

“The amendments made to the legislation do not go to the core of this bill which is deregulation which will see will see students with potentially life time debt sentences” Said Ms Steele

The National Union of Students have not been consulted on these changes to higher education and are calling for this unpopular and unfair policy to be dropped.

Students will be peacefully demonstrating against these reforms on March 25th for a National Day of Action.
