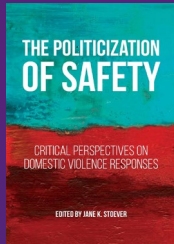

Jane Stoever is a professor at the University of California, Irvine School of Law, where she directs the Domestic Violence Clinic & the Initiative to End Family Violence & teaches Family Law & Legal Ethics. She also co-chairs the Orange County Domestic Violence Death Review Team. Her research concerns domestic violence law, family law, firearms & family violence, & feminist legal theory. She received her J.D. from Harvard Law School & her LL.M. from Georgetown University Law Center.

The Politicization of Safety calls for greater consideration of the interplay of politics, domestic violence, & how the law works in people's lives as it examines contexts including gun safety legislation, campus sexual assault responses, immigration remedies, & human rights approaches. The book provides a critical historical perspective on domestic violence legal responses in the United States, examines movement politics, & calls for more nuanced & intersectional responses to abuse.
