

How does the Oakland A's project compare?

Oakland A's at Howard Terminal

Over \$850 million in taxpayer money, including a new tax district and potential city bond

Oakland A's would own the development at Howard Terminal and can relocate in just 25 years

A's resistant to 15% onsite affordable housing — bare legal minimum

Community fund to be established, but A's will contribute ZERO private dollars
