
Support Programming at the Oakley Library!

The Librarian's Corner

I want to thank all of you for your patience and understanding of the service interruption. We experienced a network outage on January 3 due to a cyber security attack, and another outage at the end of February as remediation work to restore library services and secure the network continues. Most of our services are working again. Thanks to the County Department of Information Technology, Library IT staff, and industry experts who are upgrading and installing new security software and modernizing the Library's technology infrastructure.

As part of the improved security, we have a new email platform. My new email is Andrea. Freyler@library.cccounty.us. Please reach out to me if I have not responded to your email, as many emails were not received. Restoring services to the public has been the priority, and most services have been restored.

Library services like Link+ and some of the other online resources and databases will take a little longer to come back online. Please visit our website at <u>ccclib.org</u> for the most up-to-date information about service restoration.

On a happier note, we have many great things happening at the Oakley Library. We kick off STEAM Break on Tuesday, March 17. We will have a new hands-on project that will explore the world of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) every Tuesday through Saturday during spring break (March 17-21 and March 24-28) from 3:00 to 4:30 p.m.

Every Wednesday in April, we will host **Kindergarten Countdown** from 1:00 to 2:15 p.m. This program is for children entering kindergarten in the fall. It is designed to help children practice and learn skills that will ease the transition into kindergarten, including those related to talking, singing, reading, writing, self-care, and motor skills. We will even have snack to help prepare children for eating with others.

In May, we will have Free Comic Book Day, and Summer Reading starts in June. In the meantime, you do not want to miss our continuous programs:
