The Oakley Library is focused on providing important services in new ways. We have seen a big increase in the use of our digital resources and are looking for ways to better serve you. You can find Doug every other Friday at the Senior Center Food Distribution. You don't have to be a senior to participate. Everyone in need is welcome to pickup food, books, and learn about the library. Ms. Lisa has been visiting elementary classrooms and other community groups online to share Storytime's, information and answer questions. We understand that it can be hard to find videos on our <u>Facebook</u> page, so we have started posting Storytime's, songs, and other videos on our <u>YouTube</u> page. You can see the library one photo at a time on our new <u>Instagram</u> page.

Thanks to the Friends of the Oakley Library for sponsoring "Take & Makes". You can expect to see biweekly STEAM experiments or Storytime crafts available for pick up at the library. We will post videos of us doing each activity on our social media pages. We hope that everyone who does the activities shares them with us too. We will have other fun games and activities that can be played online or at our front door. I hope you've tried our front door service. It's easy and convenient...just make an appointment by phone or at ccclib.org/front-door-service, and your holds will be checked out and ready. Drop-ins for holds pickup is fine, too – you may just have to wait an extra minute or two while we check them out.

Unfortunately, we have had a lot of bad air days recently. When local air quality hits 150 or higher on the Air Quality Index, the library suspends Front Door service. On bad air days, please call before your visit to make sure that the library will be open. Do not worry. We keep your holds a little longer for pickup when this happens.

Sometimes it's hard to decide what to read, and that's where librarian know-how kicks in. Staff have been creating booklists for all ages and interests, accessible from ccclib.org. You can call us anytime at 625-625-2400. We are supporting busy families with curated "grab bags," an assortment of five books that can be requested by appointment online or by phone and borrowed for three weeks. Grab bags are available for baby board books, picture books, beginning readers, early/upper elementary, family audiobooks and Spanish.
