CALL SCRIPT

Hello, this is *[your name]*. I'm a *[your institution]* member working with our ONE Wake organizing team. We're sharing information with the congregation and encouraging turnout for ONE Wake's October 13th Assembly.

Are you familiar with the ONE Wake community organization?

ONE Wake is a non-partisan, multi-ethnic, multi-issue group of religious congregations, associations, and other non-profits in the Wake County area with membership representing over 50,000 households. ONE Wake works to identify grass roots issues such as the lack of affordable housing, access to jobs, and public education. Then together we organize and build relationships to obtain the power to act on these issues.
2. *[your institution]* is one of the 42 ONE Wake member organizations. Our founding public action will be a large Virtual Assembly on Tuesday, October 13, at 7:00 pm. We will have local political and business leaders present at the Assembly, and there we'll ask those leaders to publicly commit to address the top pressures facing our communities today.
