Tapping Your Social Network: Where to Find People to Register

- Don't assume people are registered
- Family
- Friends
- Someone who just moved
- Anyone new in your building or on your block?
- Someone who just moved into senior living.
- Someone who rents and moves frequently
- Someone age 18 - 21. Recent high school grads. College students
- The people you talk to as part of your job or volunteer work
- Ask the people you know if THEY know someone who might need to register.
- Ask the people you're interacting with
 - The person who delivers your groceries or your packages
 - Your barber or hairdresser
 - The receptionist at the doctor's office
 - The people who clean your house
 - Your mail carrier
 - The check-out clerk at the store
 - The plumber or repair person or handyman
 - Your clients, your patients, your customers, your co-workers.
 - Who are the people you talk to as part of your job or volunteer work?
 - What are the groups you belong to?
 - Ask the people you know if THEY know someone who might need to register.
