Justice United leaders from all our member institutions give their time and diverse talents to make Orange County a better place to live.

Our 2018 Mid-Year report celebrates the recent results of all that effort. It tells stories of success and financial investment.

Most recently we have won commitments from the Orange County Schools Board of Education to hire roughly 140 teachers of color over the next four years to match the diversity of the student body, and to hire up to 10 bi-lingual front office staff—a substantial investment from the largest employer serving rural Orange, that shapes the lives and futures of over 7,400 young people.



Justice United also won a commitment from area developer Clay Grubb to include up to 10 Glen Lennox housing units in our pilot master leasing program, an effort to more quickly house extremely low income residents.
