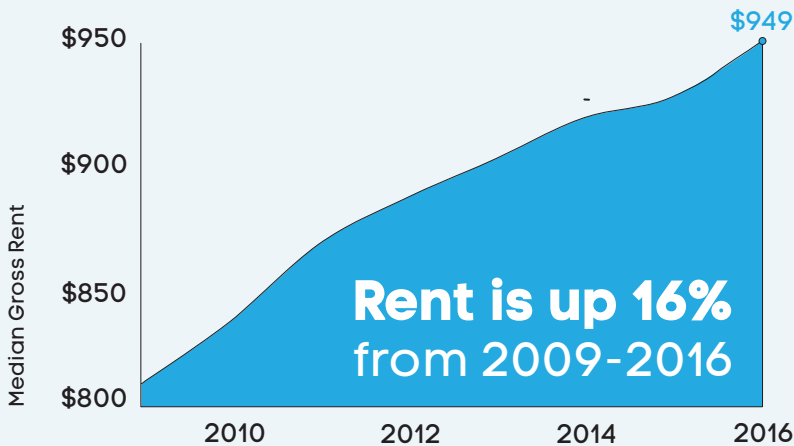


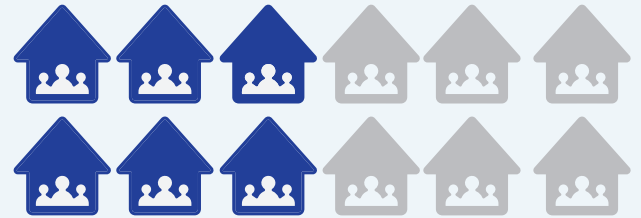

## 54% of Renters are Cost Burdened



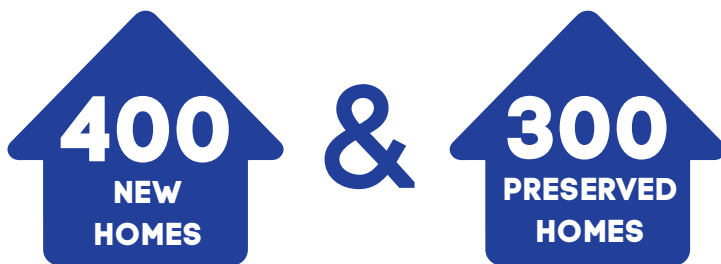
(meaning they spend more than 30% of their income on rent & utilities)
