

FALL 2018 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The end of the 2017-2018 legislative session is right around the corner, but Ohio Right to Life isn't done yet. The Ohio General Assembly will begin having sessions again after the November 6 election, in a time that many call a "lame duck" session. During these final months of the General Assembly, Ohio Right to Life has two important bills we want to get across the finish line.

⬆️ Dismemberment Abortion Ban - S.B. 145

➡️ Ohio Right to Life has been fighting for this for the past two years. The legislation would prohibit dilation and evacuation abortions, a procedure in which the abortionist first dilates the woman's cervix and then uses steel instruments to dismember and extract the baby from the uterus.

➡️ The D&E abortion procedure is usually performed between thirteen and twenty-four weeks LMP. In 2015, the Ohio Department of Health reported nearly 3,000 D&E abortions in the state of Ohio.

➡️ This bill last had a hearing in March, and is waiting on a final committee vote in the House Criminal Justice Committee, and a House floor vote before it can move to the Governor's desk.

⬆️ Unborn Child Dignity Act - S.B. 28

➡️ This legislation would require that aborted fetal remains be treated humanely after an abortion.

➡️ The legislation is two-pronged. The first part requires that aborted children's remains be either given earthly burial or cremation. The second part is Unborn Dignity Informed Consent, which increases informed consent by requiring full disclosure to women pursuing abortions of their options for the aborted baby's treatment.

➡️ This bill was voted out of the House Health Committee in February, and is waiting on a House floor vote before it can move to the Governor's desk.
