To Whom It May Concern,

The person providing you with this letter is a volunteer with the Ohio Rights Group. This volunteer is gathering signatures to place the Ohio Cannabis Rights Amendment on the ballot. The activity in which this volunteer is engaging is a protected activity under the state and federal constitutions.

Every effort has been made to follow state and local laws concerning petitioning near polling locations. The volunteer has been instructed, among other things:

- To stay beyond 100 feet of the polling location, as marked by the U.S. flags;
- To stay at least 10 feet away from any elector standing in line to vote, if the line extends beyond the 100-foot prohibited area; and,
- Not to solicit or in any manner attempt to influence any elector in casting the elector's vote.

The Ohio Rights Group and its volunteers understand that you have a duty to protect the elections process, and they appreciate your service in doing so. I trust that you understand also your duty to recognize the free speech activity in which the Ohio Rights Group and its volunteers are engaged, and your duty to allow that free speech continue without interference as long as it is in accordance with the law.
