Stop the Download and Automation of ODSP

TO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF ONTARIO:

WHEREAS the Ontario government plans to download the Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) onto municipalities starting in June 2022 and automating the application process for social assistance.

WHEREAS municipalities across Ontario have been severely impacted financially by COVID-19 and cannot afford to take on the responsibility of the cost of the program.

WHEREAS the high success rate of appeals to the Social Benefits Tribunal (SBT) suggests problems with the application process and the initial adjudication of applications, and it can take years for an appeal to the SBT.

WHEREAS any individuals attempting to access the SBT are living with a disability or chronic illness, may lack access to technology or legal support, and are also dealing with the many challenges of living through the pandemic.

WHEREAS the current social assistance rates for both ODSP and Ontario Works are well below the poverty line and people need proper financial assistance to be able to pay for the additional cost of COVID-19, housing, food, supplies, and beyond.

WHEREAS casework requires human interaction between workers and recipients, and no one should be at risk to lose their jobs if the government decides to amalgamate ODSP and Ontario Works.

THEREFORE we the undersigned petition the Legislative Assembly of Ontario to stop the download and automation of ODSP and increase social assistance rates to bring people out of poverty.
