Governance	Molly	Campaign Extension Requests:  We have had two members ask for an extension past the campaign deadline to be able to fulfill their financial offering. The total of these two members is roughly \$15,000. At least one of them is waiting for money to come out of an alternative investment.  Board would need to decide if we are ok with doing this, and notify the rest of the membership that we have extended two individuals past the March 31, 2020 deadline. We'd need to do the notification of this prior to the official close of the campaign.  - Molly indicated she will work on the legal needs for this prior to sending to Dorsy to help save us some money.  - There is also a church wanting to loan us \$20,000 but it would not be available until January 1, 2021. Board discussed how we should work outside of the current offering program since we can take loans at any time from anyone.  - How do the loans that come outside of the original impact our agreement with Merge? We are asking for the commitments now, so we are basing it on them. What moves Merge forward is a board vote. It doesn't say that we have to be at \$1.6M. They have been tied to the same date but if we extend the offering we will need to make a decision on Merge prior to the offering.
