

Paint4Freedom Privacy Statement and Policy

Welcome to paint4Freedom.org / .au website and online services of Paint4Freedom Limited (referred to as '**Paint4Freedom**' or '**we**', '**our**' and '**us**'). This Privacy Statement has been prepared in accordance with The Australian *Privacy Act 1988* ('**Privacy Act**') and Australian Privacy Principles and outlines the Paint4Freedom Privacy Policy. By using this website or our other online services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

1. **This Privacy Statement explains** how we may collect information and what information of yours we may collect, how that information will be used, and how you can control the correction and/or deletion of that information. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Statement.

2. **The collecting of Information**

Your personal information may be collected during your interactions with us, including:

- Our online services associated with paint4freedom.org / .au websites
- Payments (electronic or otherwise) made to us or one of our authorised agents or partners
- Online / digital / electronic media including third party websites
- Online services or networks including social media networks
- Entering the paint4Freedom National Art Competition (whether online or otherwise, including through one of our authorised agents or partners)
- Through our authorised agents and partners
- If a parent/guardian enters the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition on behalf of a child
- If an authorised gallery or agent enters the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition on behalf of an artist

3. **Information We Collect**

User-Provided Information:

If you register with us (for example through one of our websites paint4freedom.org / .au), you may provide us with personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. This may include, but is not limited to, your title, name, email address, phone number, country of residence, postcode, address, date of birth, and credit/debit card information (if involved in a financial transaction). We refer to this personally identifiable information as '**Personal Information**'.

If you register with paint4freedom.org / .au (including by "following," "liking," linking your account to paint4freedom.org / .au, etc., on a third party website or network) we may also collect Personal Information about you.

If you correspond with us by email, we may retain the content of your email messages, your email address and our responses. We may also retain any messages you send through paint4freedom.org / .au. You may provide us information in user content you post to paint4freedom.org/au, which we may also retain.

4. **Children's Privacy**

We do not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from anyone under the age of 13 years of age or knowingly allow such persons to register for paint4freedom.org / .au accounts or to enter the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition. If you are under 13, please do not send any Personal Information about yourself to us and we ask that you do not contact us through any means including any social media platform. If you believe that we might have any information from or about a child under the age of 13, please contact us at Privacy@paint4freedom.org as soon as possible.

In the course of providing our services, including conducting the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition, we may ask the parents or guardians of a person under the age of 18 (but never under the age of 13) ('**Child**' or '**Children**') to provide Personal Information regarding their Children (or to consent to a Child providing such information). If we become aware that we have collected Personal Information from or about a Child without consent from a parent or guardian, we will take steps to remove that information from our servers or replace it with Personal Information provided with the consent of a parent or guardian.

5. **Third Party Services**

Paint4Freedom uses the NationBuilder platform to host paint4freedom.org /.au and organise our community of members, supporters and prospects including some aspects of the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition. You can read more about that company and its features and policies at NationBuilder.com. When you visit paint4freedom.org /.au, NationBuilder may send one or more cookies - a small text file containing a string of alphanumeric characters - to your computer that uniquely identifies your browser and lets NationBuilder help you log in faster and enhance your navigation through paint4freedom.org /.au. A cookie does not collect personal information about you. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the site. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser's directions. A session cookie is temporary and disappears after you close your browser. You can reset your web browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some features of paint4freedom.org /.au may not function properly if the ability to accept cookies is disabled. You can read more about how the NationBuilder service interacts with and protects your information at nationbuilder.com/privacy and nationbuilder.com/confidentiality.

Paint4freedom.org /.au may use Google Analytics to help understand use of paint4freedom.org /.au. This service collects the information sent by your browser as part of a web page request, including cookies and your IP address, and their use of it is governed by their Privacy Policy or Statement.

6. How We Use Your Information

We use the personal information you submit to operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of paint4freedom.org /.au, for the management of the Paint4Freedom National Art Competition and for related services.

By providing us or paint4freedom.org /.au/ your email address (including by "following," "liking," linking your account to paint4freedom.org /.au, etc., on a third party website or network), you consent to our using the email address to send you paint4freedom.org /.au/Paint4Freedom and/or Paint4Freedom Art Competition related notices, including any notices required by law, in lieu of communication by postal mail. You also agree that we may send you notifications of activity on paint4freedom.org /.au and /or Paint4Freedom Art Competition related notices to the email address you give us, in accordance with any applicable privacy settings. We may use your email address to send you other messages, such as newsletters, changes to features of paint4freedom.org /.au, Paint4Freedom National Art Competition details, details, notices or other information. If you do not want to receive such email messages, you may opt out at the Paint4Freedom unsubscribe page.

Following termination or deactivation of your Paint4Freedom account, we may retain your profile information and user content for a reasonable time for archival purposes. Furthermore, we may retain and continue to use indefinitely all information (including user content) contained in your communications to other users or posted to public or semi-public areas of paint4freedom.org /.au after termination or deactivation of your account.

Paint4Freedom reserves the right, but has no obligation, to monitor the user content you post on paint4freedom.org /.au. We reserve the right to remove any such information or material for any reason or no reason, including without limitation if in our sole opinion such information or material violates, or may violate, any applicable law or to protect or defend our rights or property or those of any third party. Paint4Freedom also reserves the right to remove information upon the request of any third party.

7. How We Share Your Information

Personally Identifiable Information: we will not rent or sell your Personal Information to others. We may share your Personal Information with third parties for the purpose of providing paint4freedom.org /.au services to you. If we do this, such third parties' use of your information will be bound by this Privacy Statement. We may store personal information in locations outside the direct control of Paint4Freedom (for instance, on servers or databases co-located with hosting providers). This may include the storage of information offshore, including the United States of America. I would prefer we don't use anywhere else other than the US given our overall purpose here. I'll check and watch the NationBuilder blogs about location/s of their servers.

Any personal information or content that you voluntarily disclose for posting to paint4freedom.org /.au, such as user content, becomes available to the public, as controlled by any applicable privacy or website customization settings. If you remove information that you posted to paint4freedom.org /.au,

copies may remain viewable in cached and archived pages or if other users have copied or saved that information.

Except as otherwise described in this Privacy Statement, we will not disclose Personal Information to any third party unless required to do so by law or subpoena or if we believe that such action is necessary to (a) conform to the law, comply with legal process served on us or our affiliates, or investigate, prevent, or take action regarding suspected or actual illegal activities; (b) to enforce this policy, take precautions against liability, to investigate and defend ourselves against any third-party claims or allegations, to assist government enforcement agencies, or to protect the security or integrity of our site; and (c) to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of us, our users or others.

8. Your Choices About Your Information

Australian Privacy Principle 6 of the Privacy Act allows you to get access to, and correct, the personal information we hold about you in certain circumstances. If you would like to obtain such access, please contact us on the details set out above.

Please note that the access and correction requirements under this Privacy Policy operates alongside and do not replace other informal or legal procedures by which an individual can be provided access to, or correction of, their Personal Information, including the requirements under the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (Cth).

9. How We Protect Your Information

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. To protect your Personal Information, we take reasonable precautions and follow commercially reasonable practices to make sure it is not inappropriately lost, misused, accessed, disclosed, altered or destroyed.

If you provide us with your credit card information, this information is encrypted using commercially reasonable technology and stored using commercially reasonable encryption practises.

10. Compromise of Personal Information

In the event that Personal Information is compromised as a result of a breach of security, Paint4Freedom will promptly notify those persons whose Personal Information has been compromised.

11. Links to Other Web Sites

We are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from paint4freedom.org / .au nor the information or content contained therein. Please remember that when you use a link to go from paint4freedom.org / .au to another website, our Privacy Statement and Policy are no longer in effect. Your browsing and interaction on any other website, including those that have a link on our website, is subject to that website's own rules and policies. Please read over those rules and policies before proceeding.

12. Notification Procedures

It is our policy to provide notifications, whether such notifications are required by law or are for marketing or other business or Paint4Freedom Art Competition related purposes, to you via email notice, written or hard copy notice, or through conspicuous posting of such notice on paint4freedom.org / .au, as determined by Paint4Freedom in its sole discretion. We reserve the right to determine the form and means of providing notifications to you, provided that you may opt out of certain means of notification as described in this Privacy Statement.

13. Consent

You warrant that you are able to give consents under Australian Law or, in the event that you do not have the capacity to give consent, you warrant that your guardian or attorney is able to give any consent required under this Privacy Statement and Policy on your behalf.

You hereby expressly and voluntarily grant your informed consent to us to deal with your Personal Information in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Privacy Statement and Policy. Should

you retract your consent, please contact us. If you retract your consent, you acknowledge and agree that failure to provide certain types of Personal Information may not give you access to the full functionality of our services.

14. **Changes to Our Privacy Statement and Policy**

If we change our privacy policies and procedures, we will post those changes on paint4freedom.org /[.au](http://paint4freedom.org.au) to keep you aware of what information we collect, how we use it and under what circumstances we may disclose it. Changes to this Privacy Statement and Policy are effective when they are posted on this page.
