When we read from a book, a newspaper or a webpage, we read WORDS, just like you are doing now.

And we can also read MUSIC!
But when we read music, we read in NOTES and SYMBOLS.

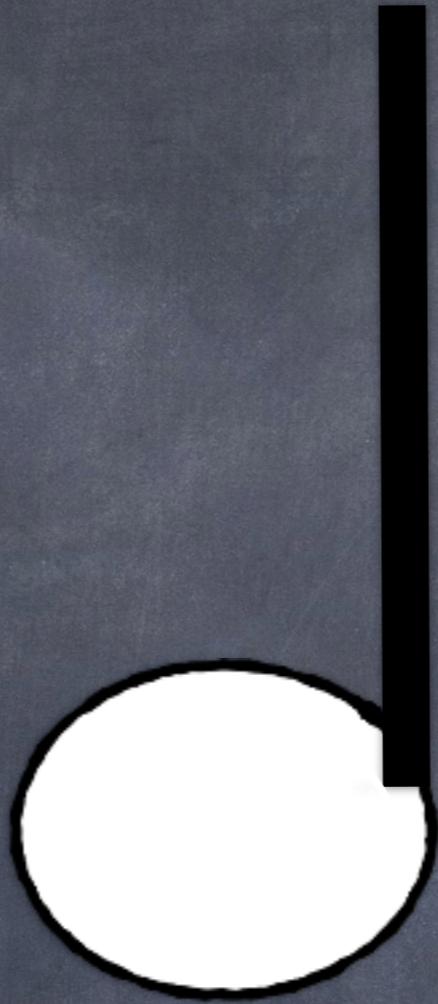
Here's how...



This 'note' is called a CROTCHET or a quarter note.

It is worth 1 beat.

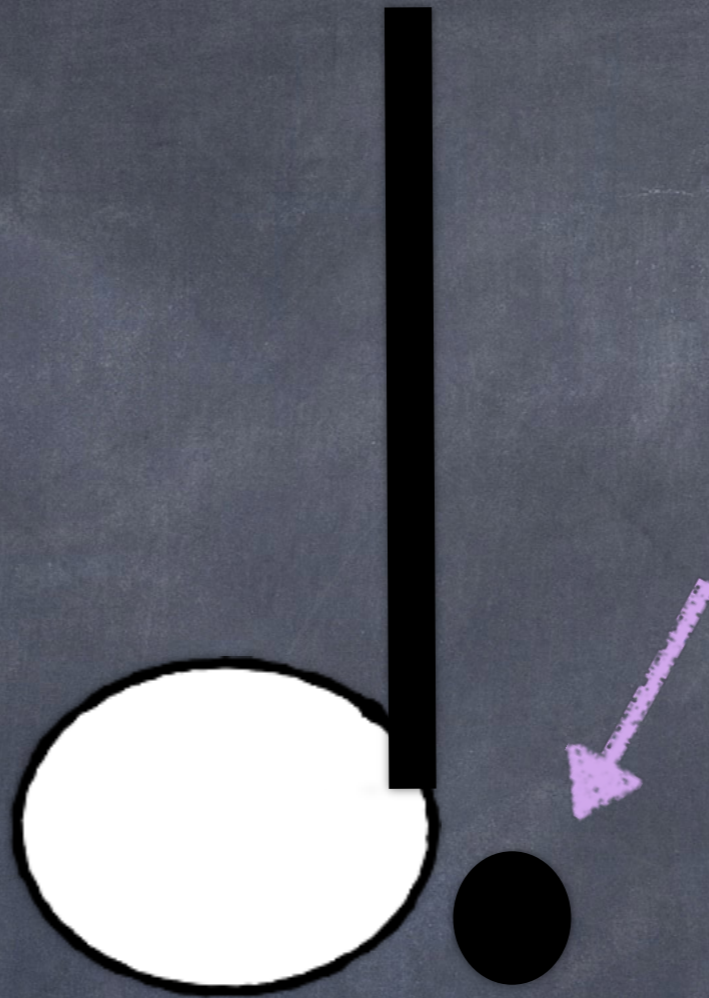
(I'll explain what that means later)



This note is called a MINIM or a
half note.

It is worth 2 beats.

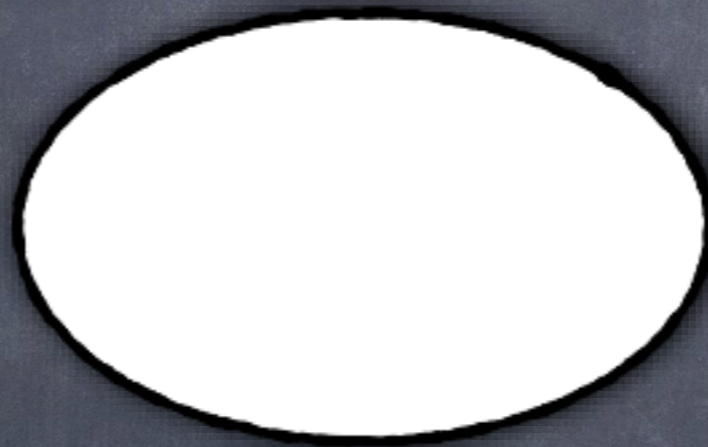
(See that the circle is white)



This note is called a
DOTTED MINIM or a
dotted half note.

It is worth 3 beats.

(See the 'dot' next to the note)



This note is called a SEMIBREVE or a whole note.

It is worth 4 beats.

(It has no tail and looks like a squashed circle)

Beats are like claps

Can you clap your hands and count to 4?

Let's have a go!

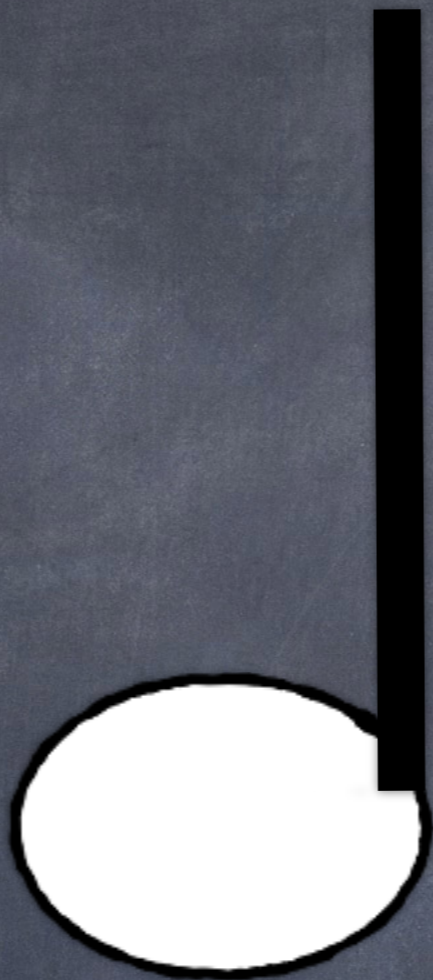


Here is the crotchet.

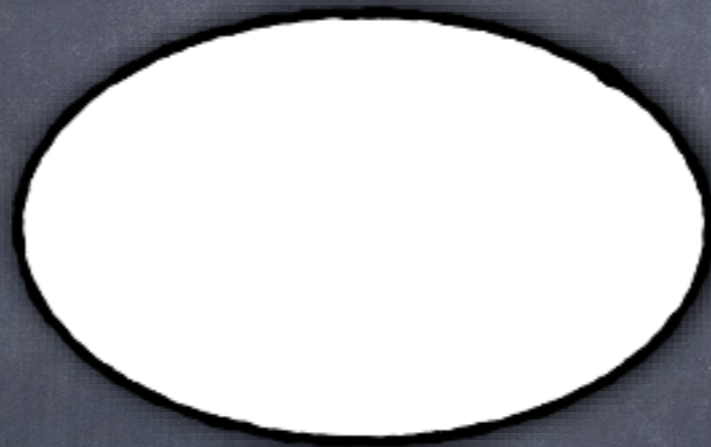

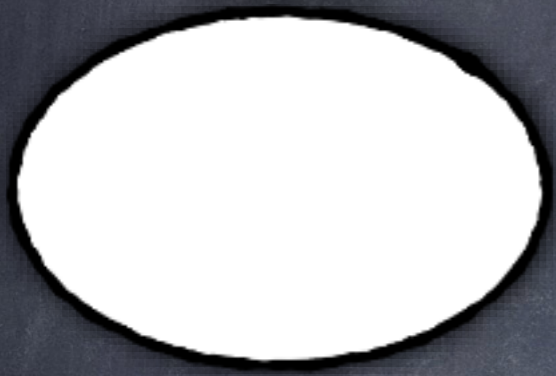
