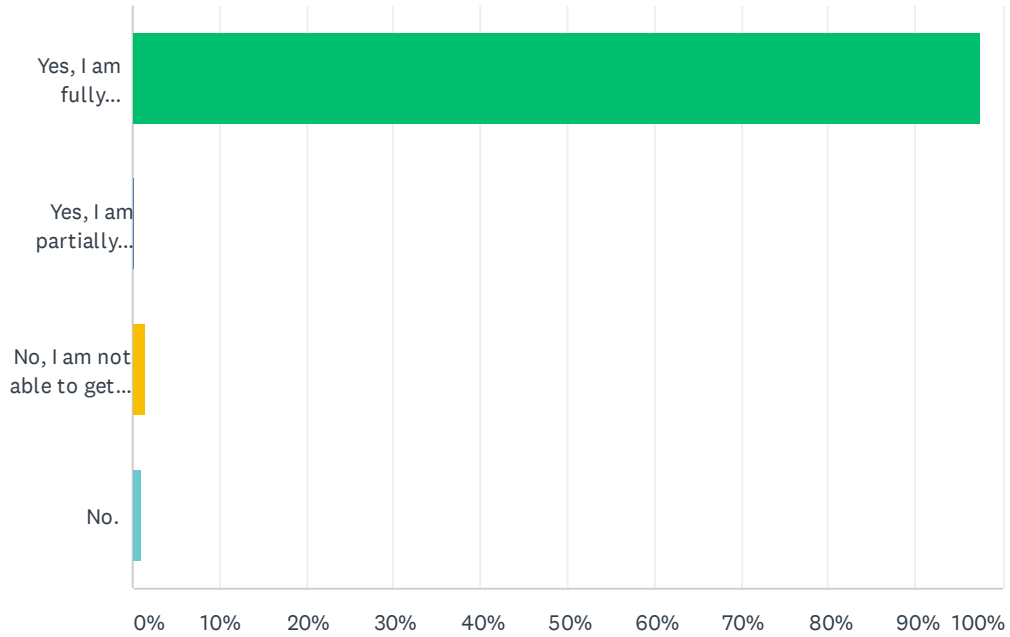


Q1 Have you received a COVID-19 vaccine?

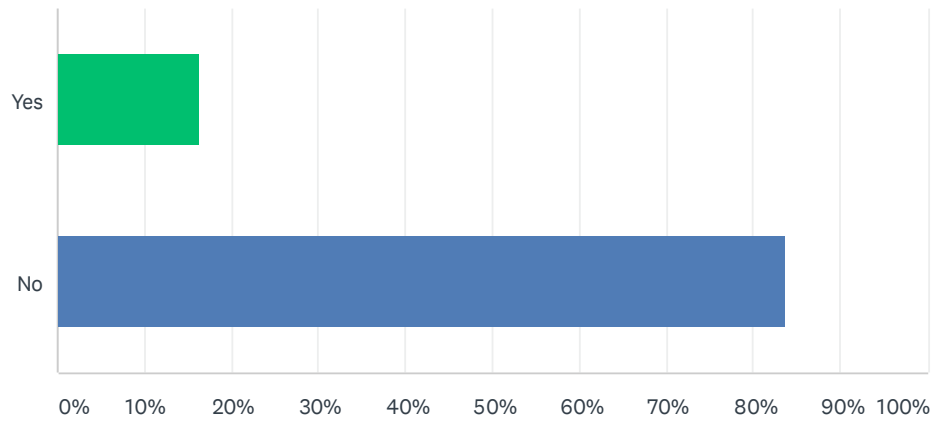

Q2 Do you live with, or are responsible for, the care of someone who is high risk and/or unable to receive a vaccine due to a medical condition?

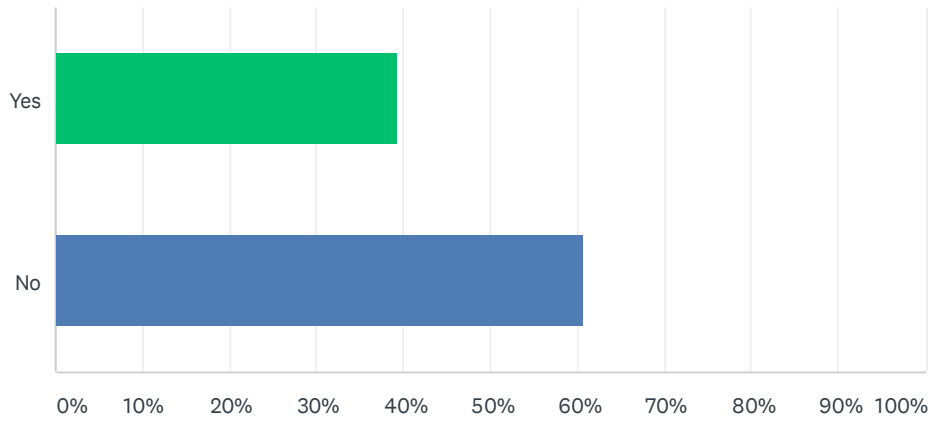

Q3 Are there children below the age of 12 in your home?

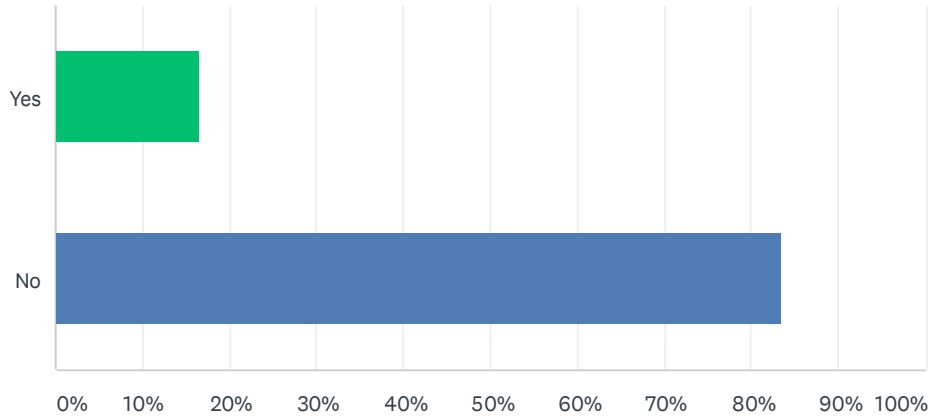

Q4 Are you immunocompromised or have another significant health condition that puts you at high risk of serious illness from COVID-19, despite being fully vaccinated?

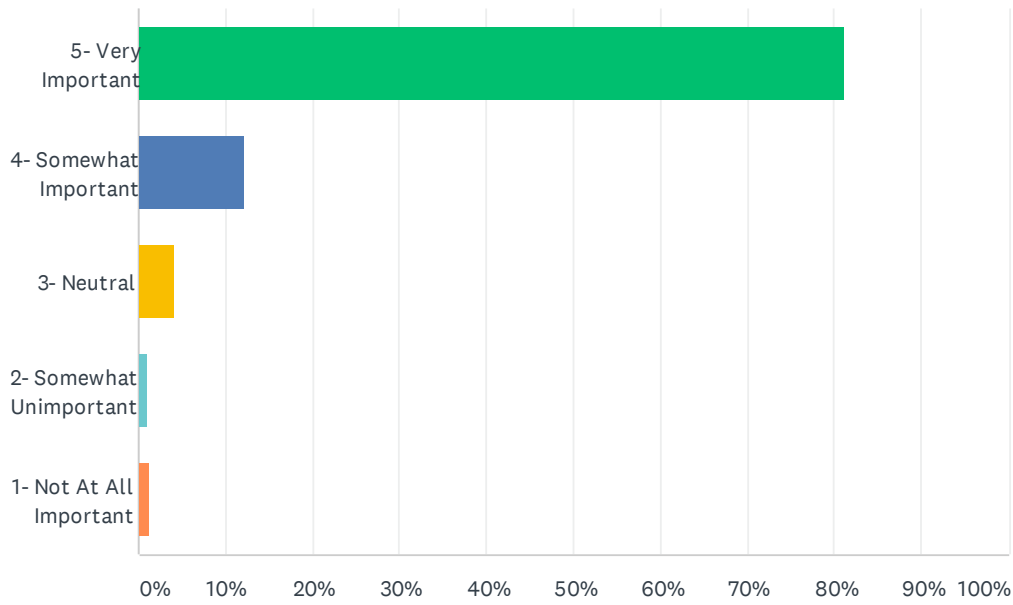

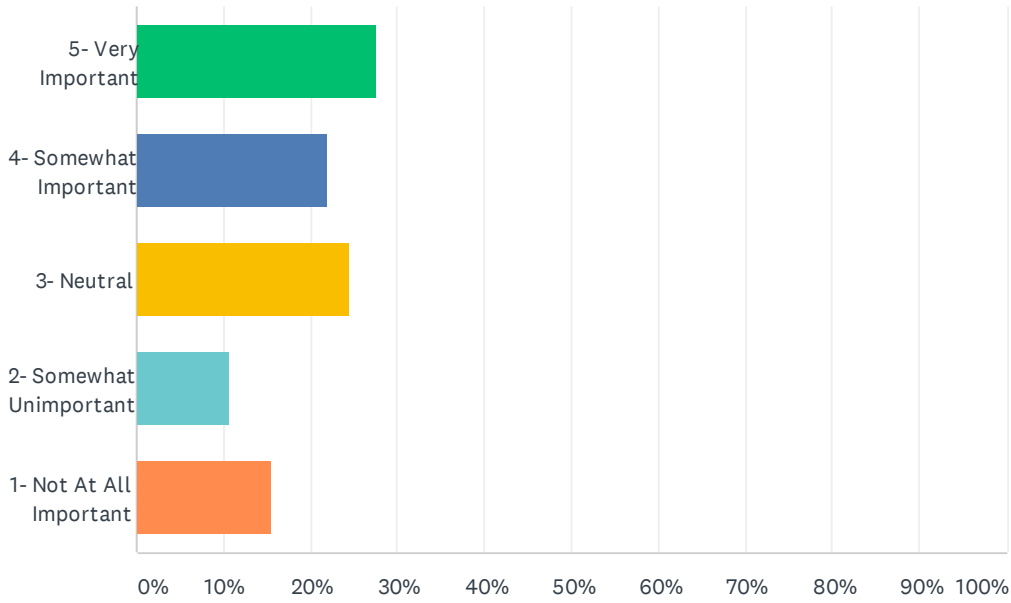

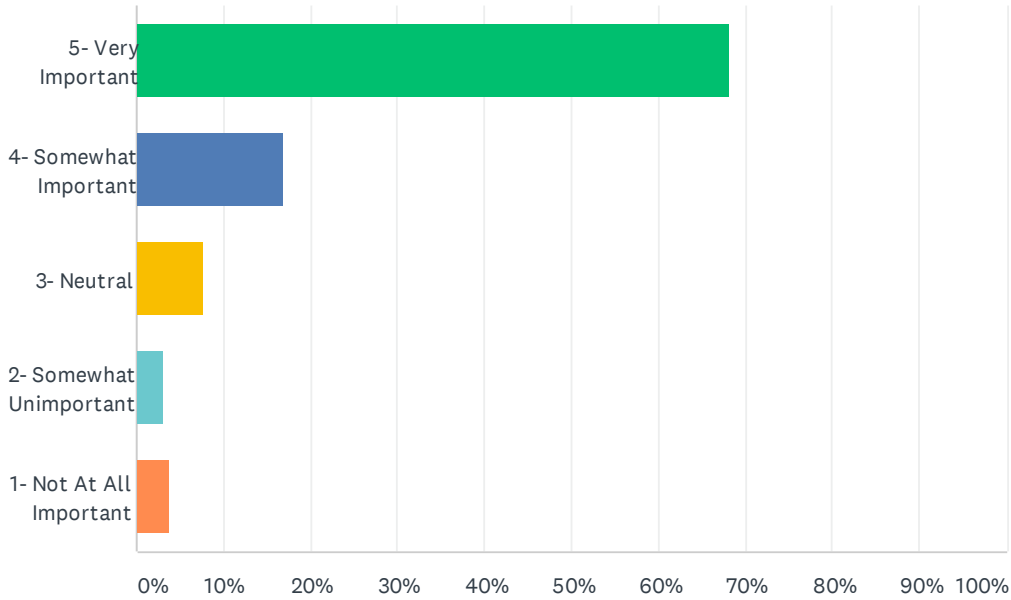

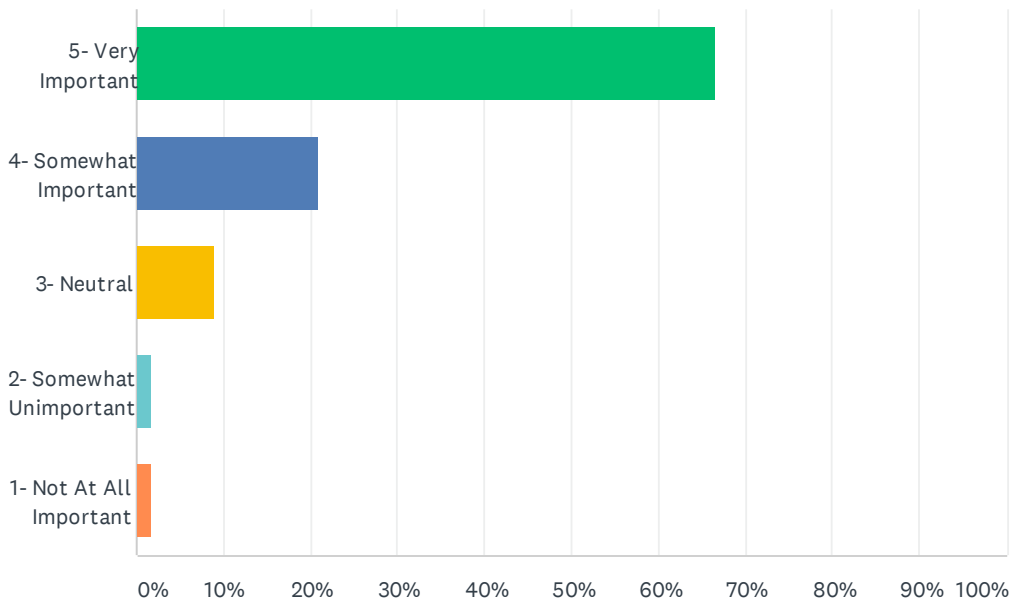

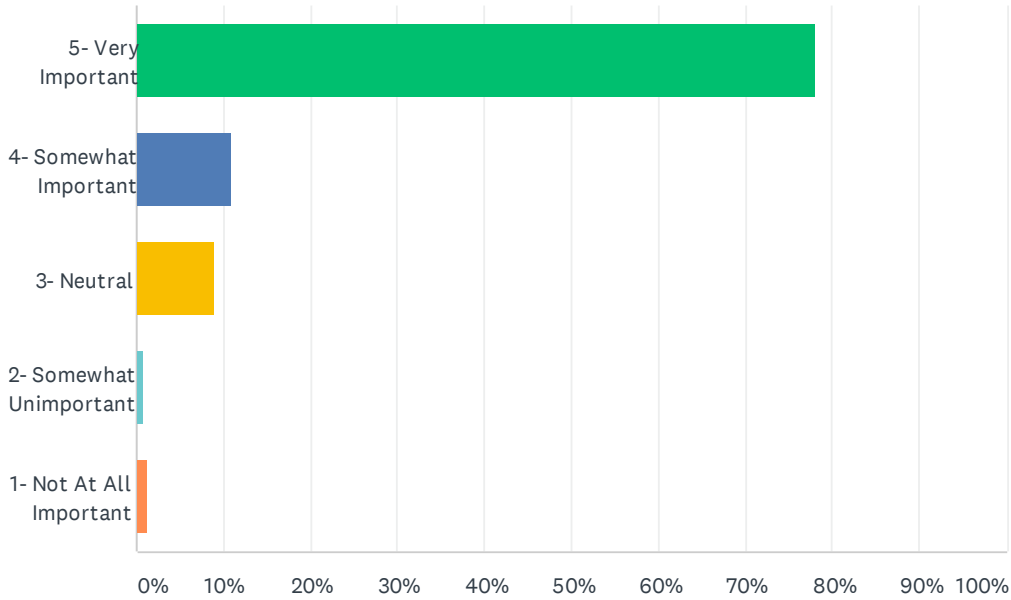

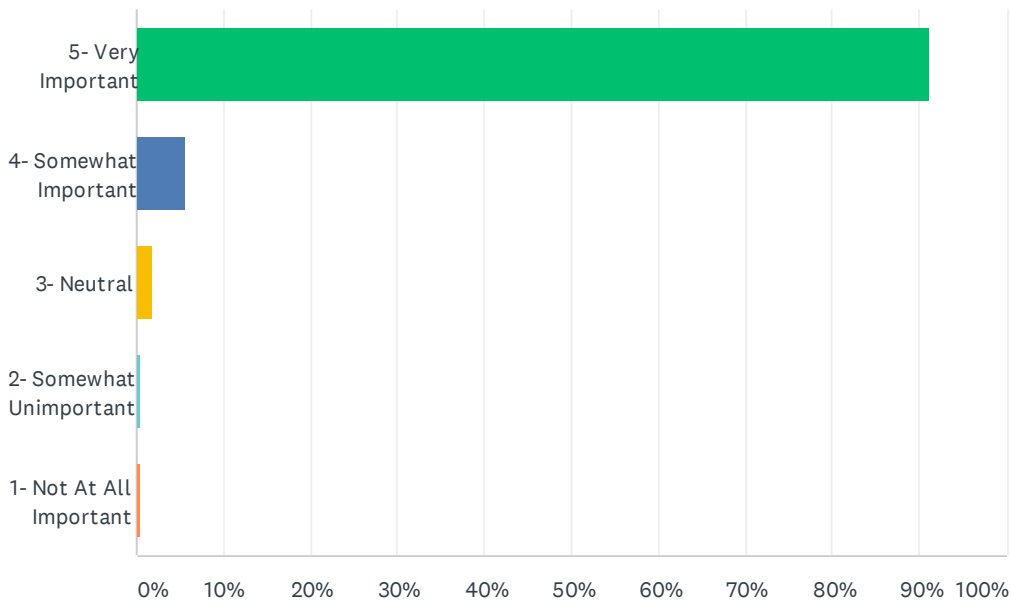

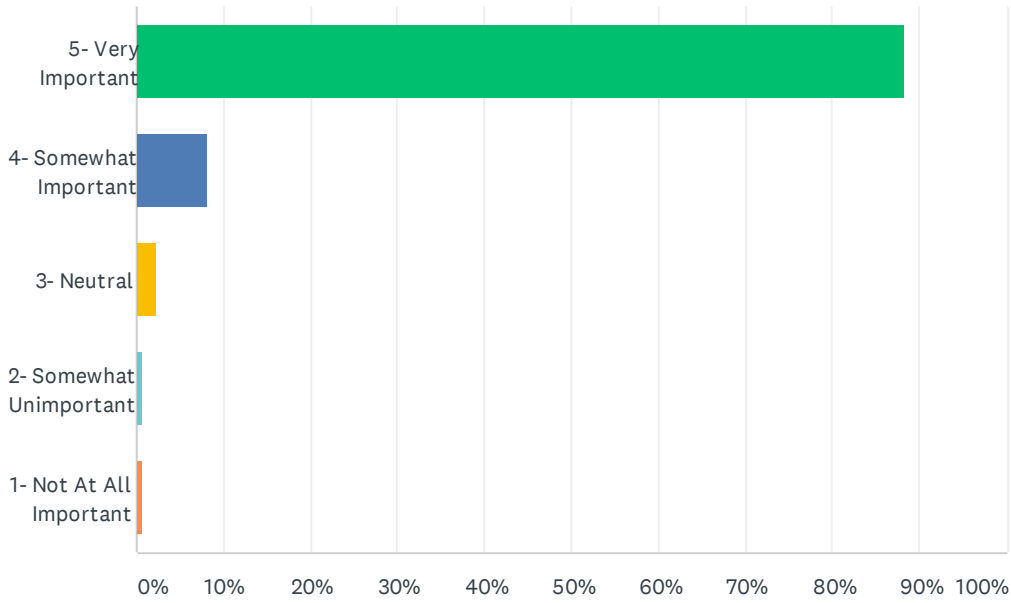

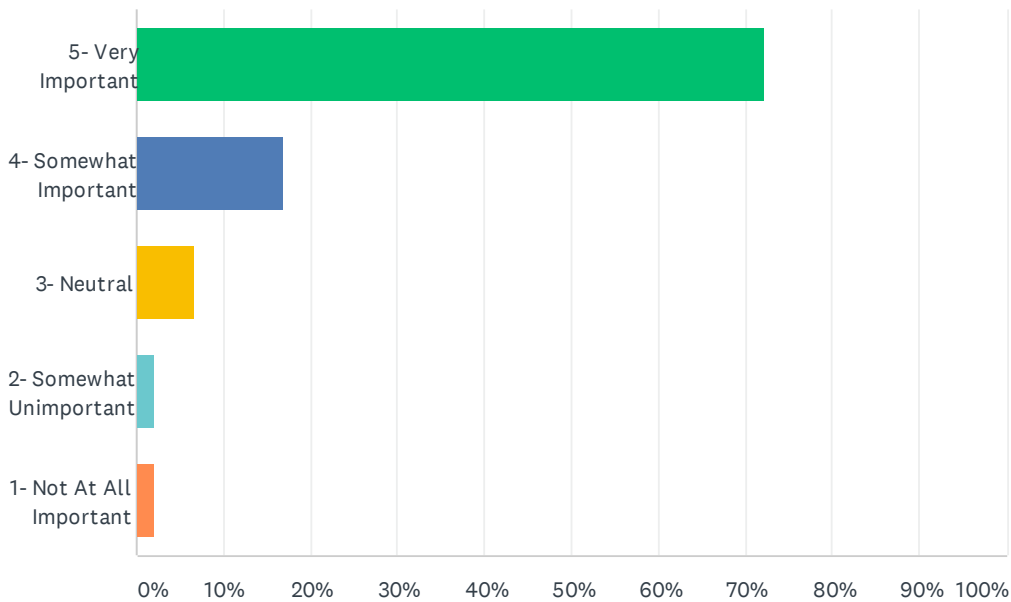

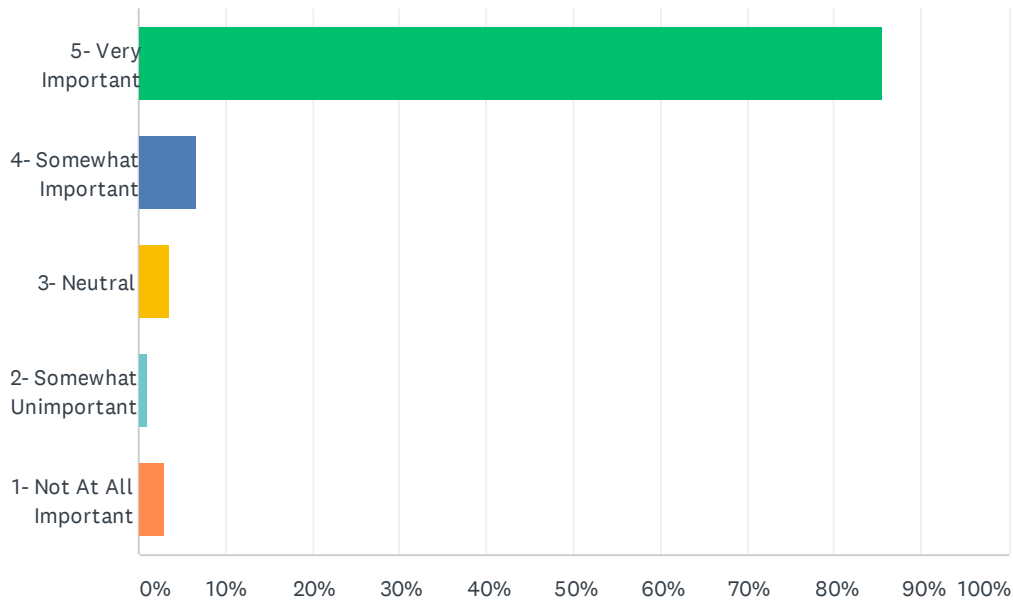

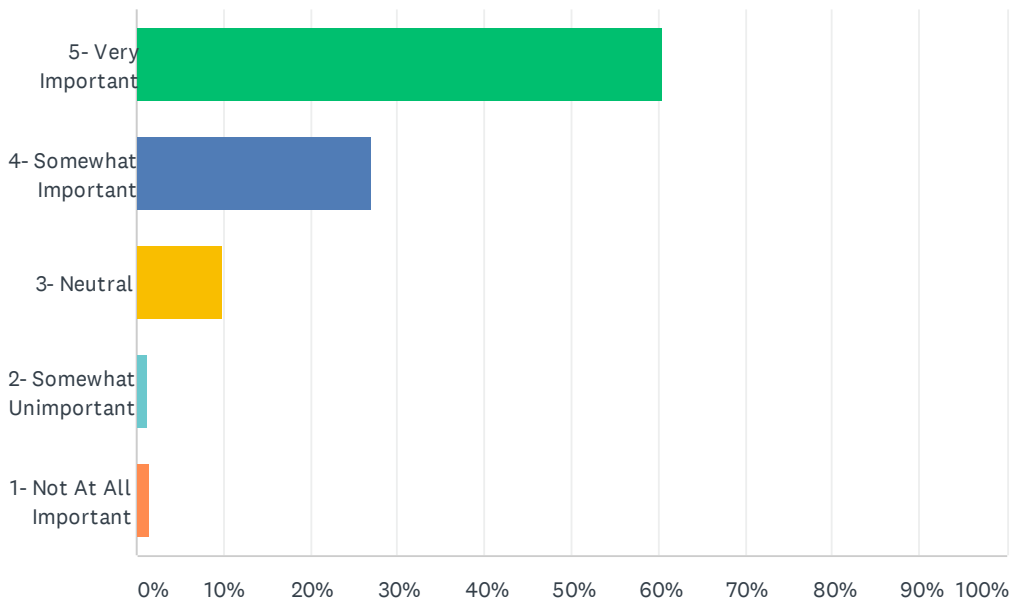

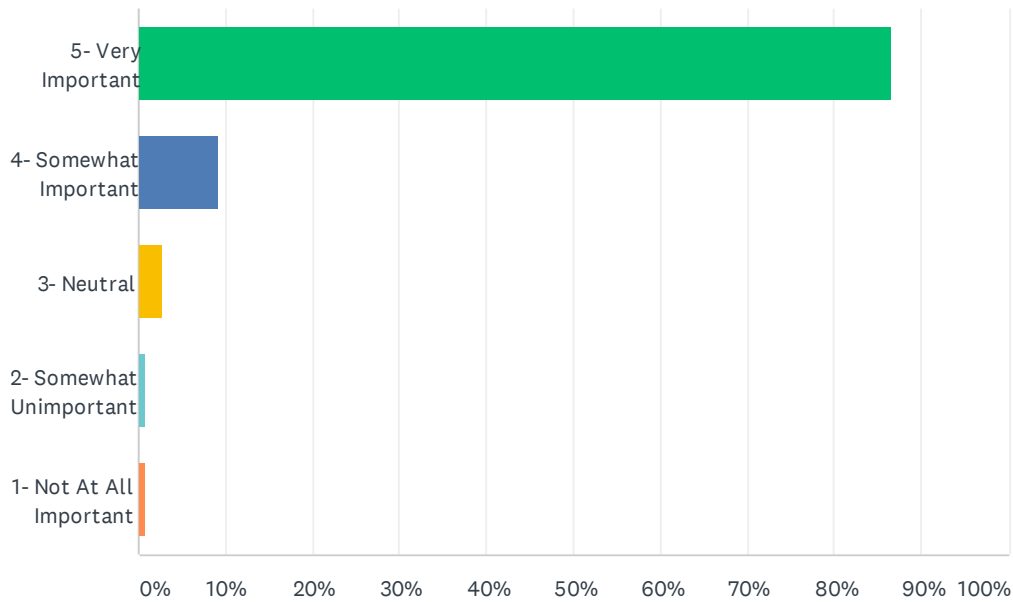

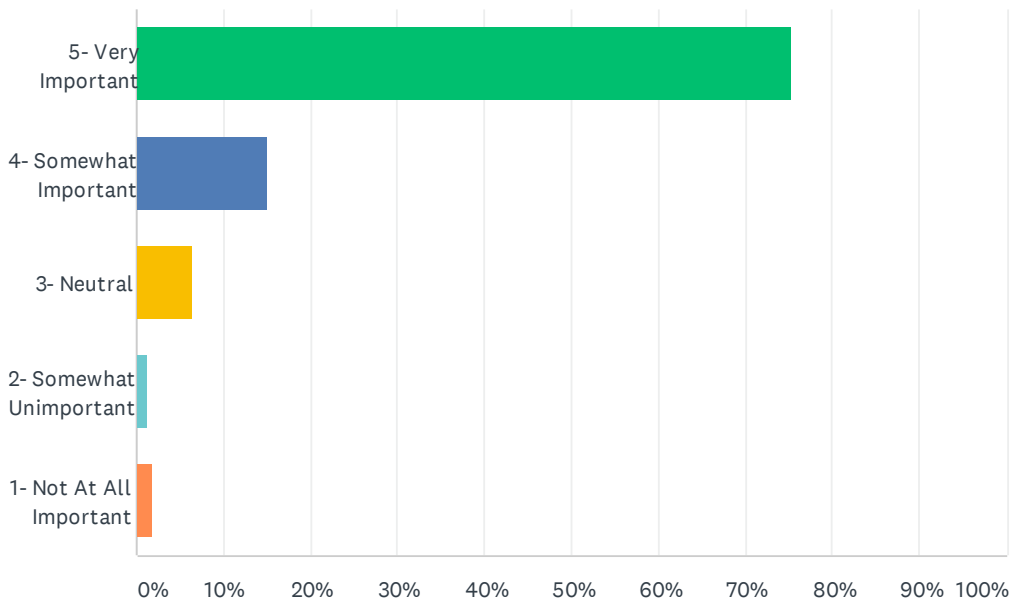

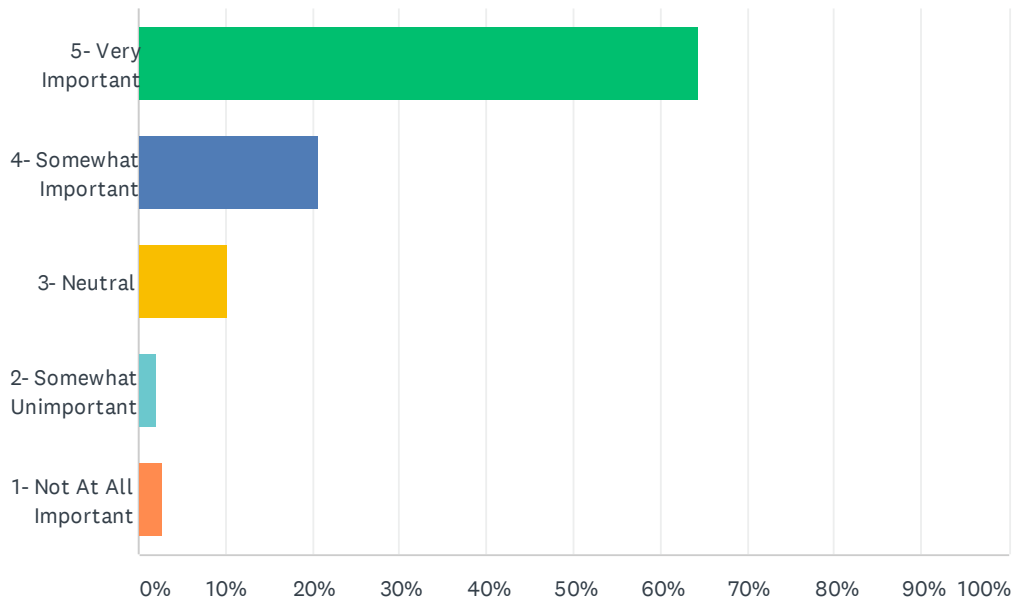

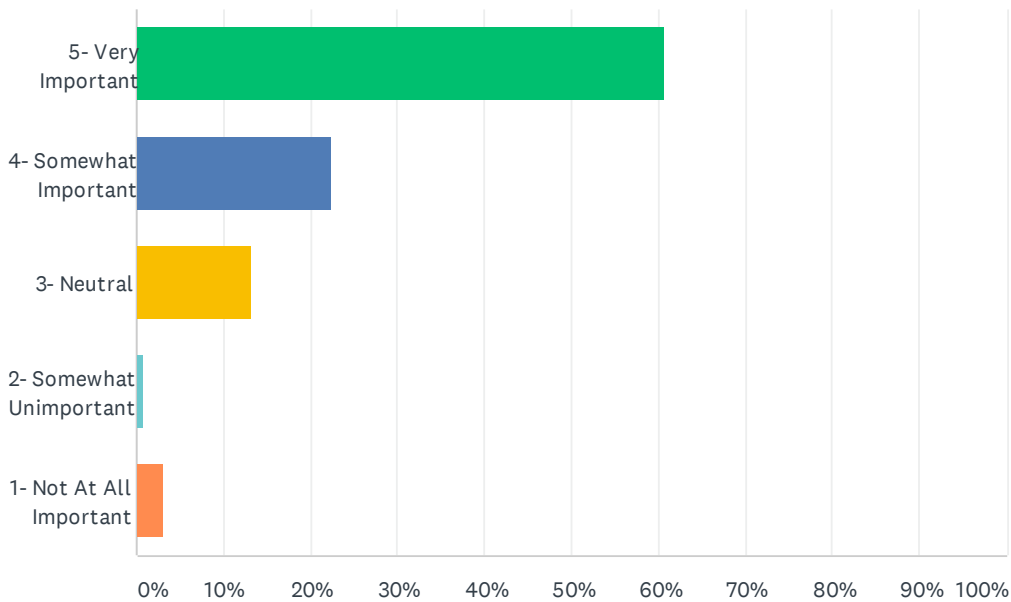

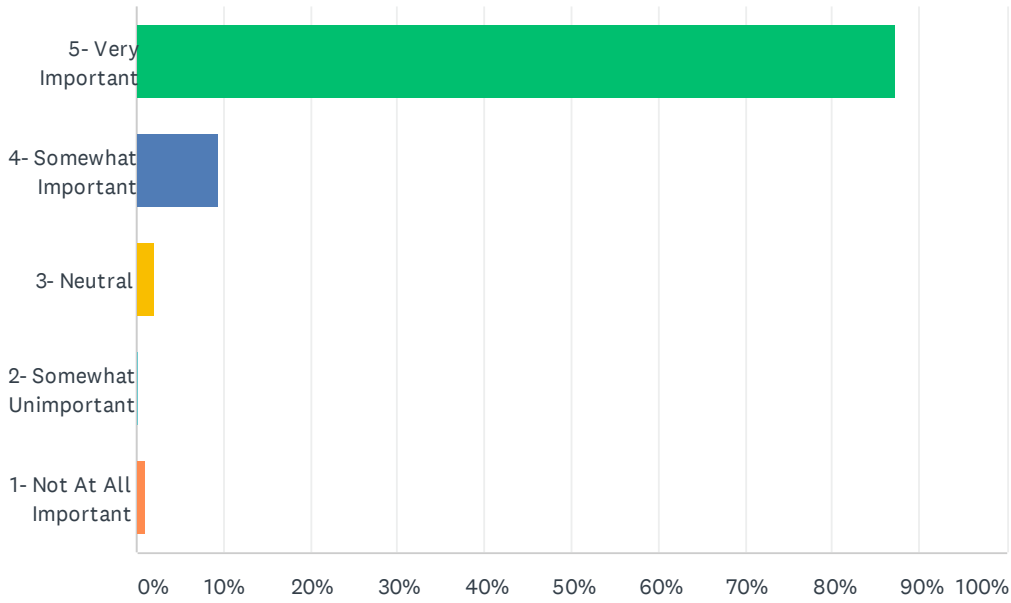

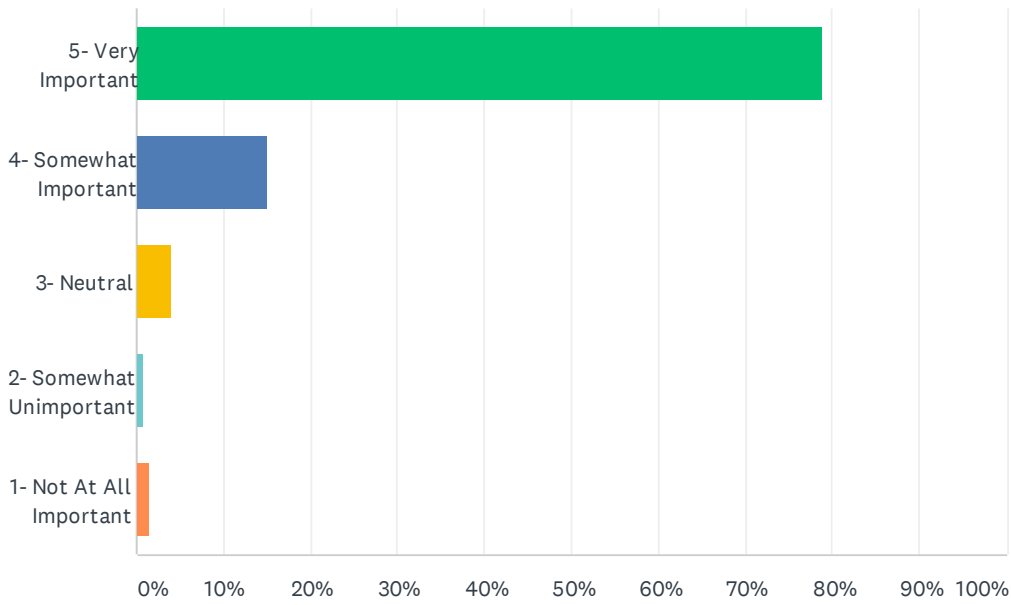

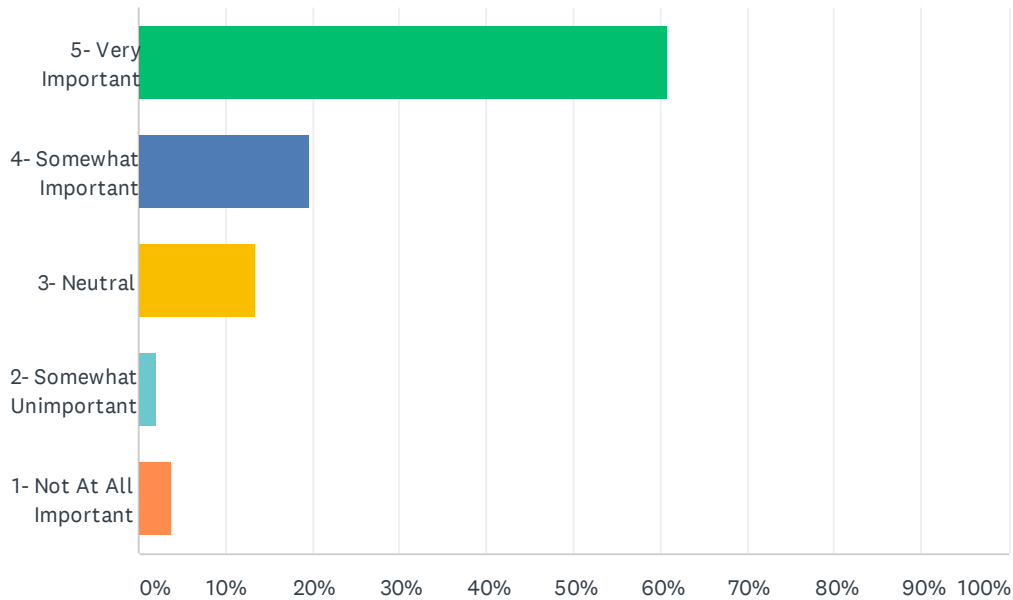

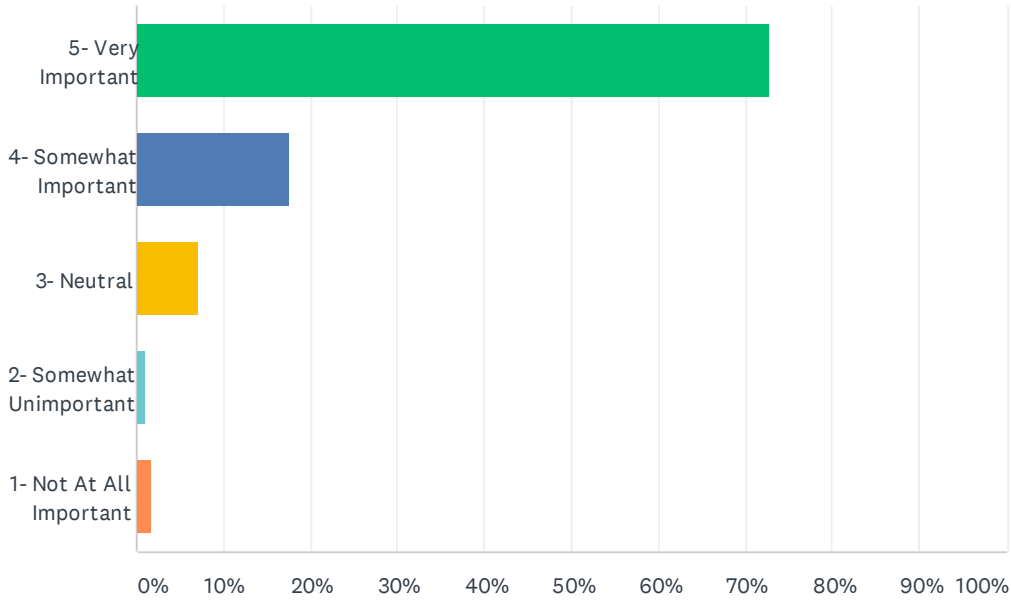

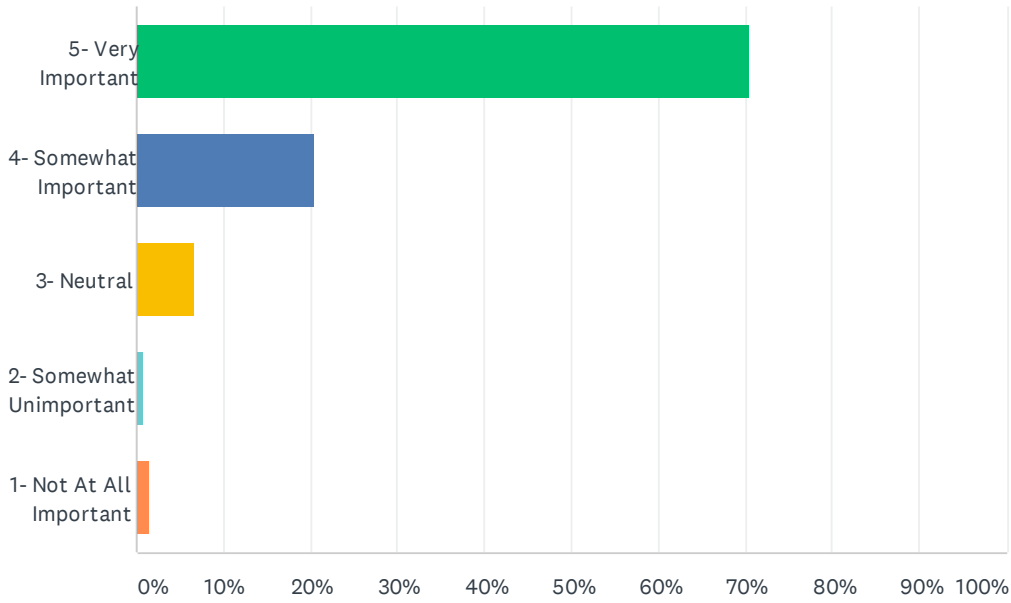

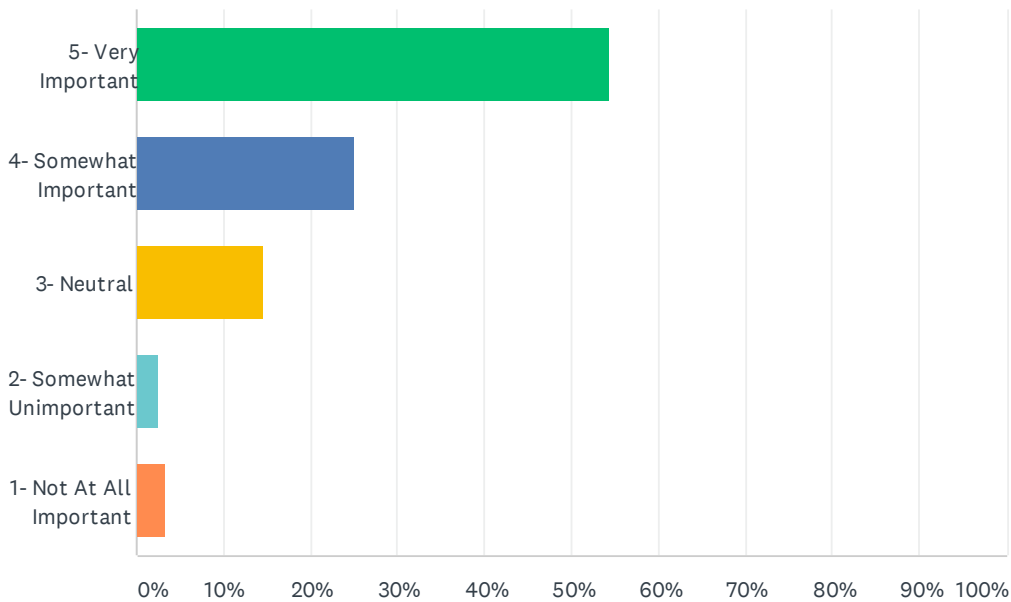

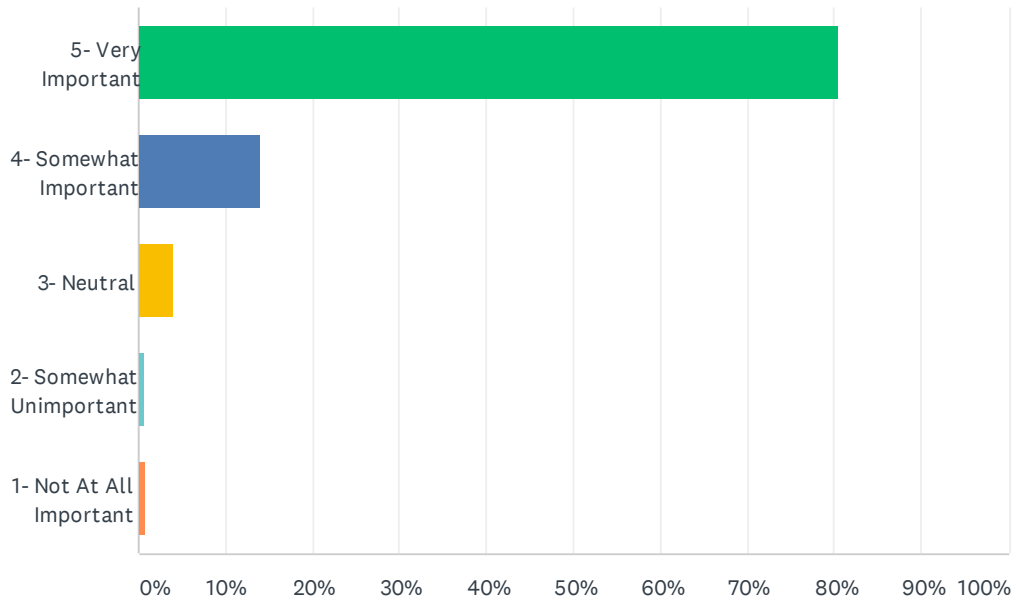

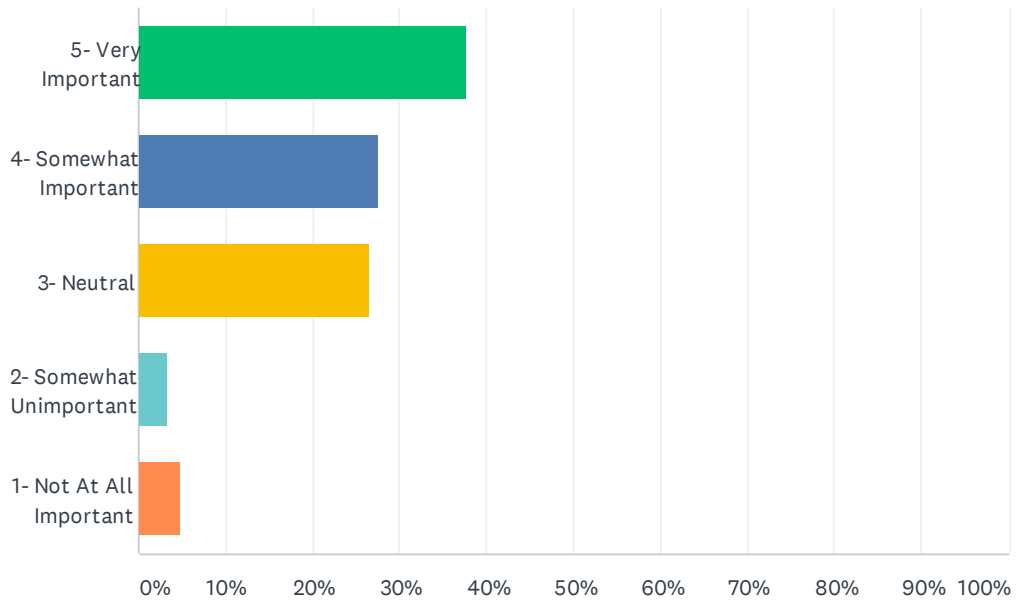

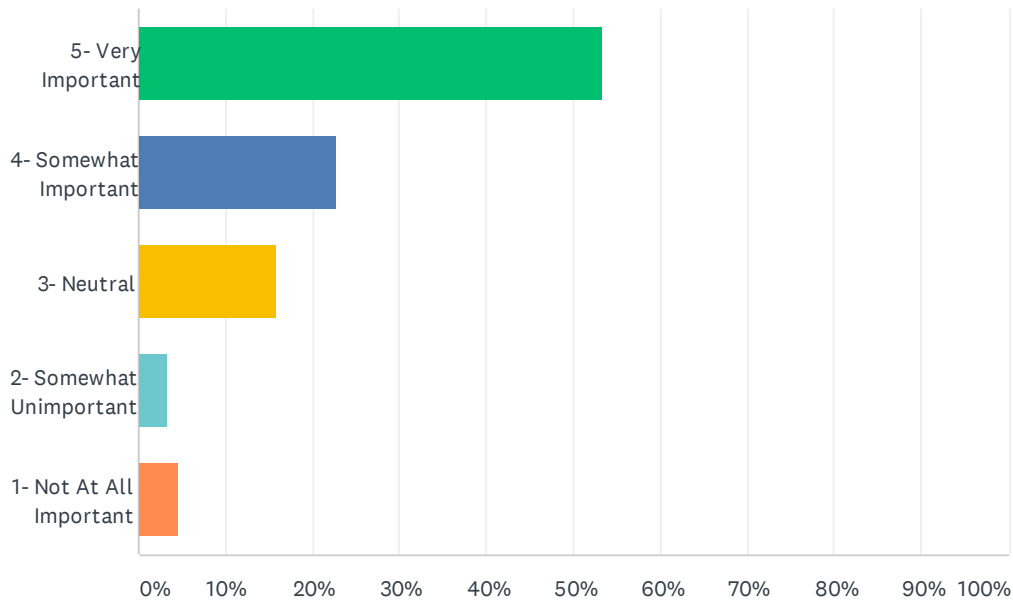

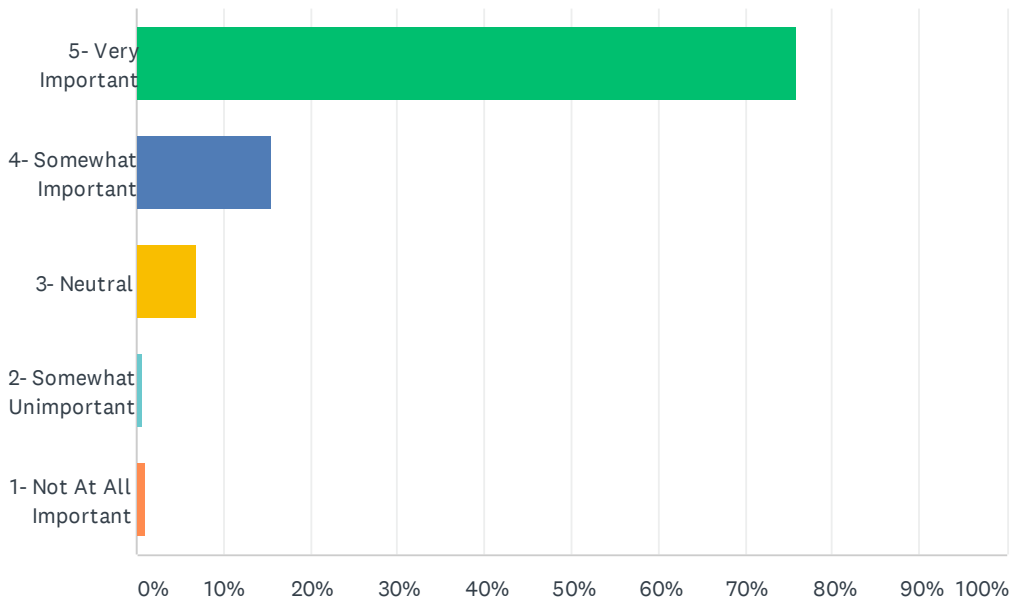

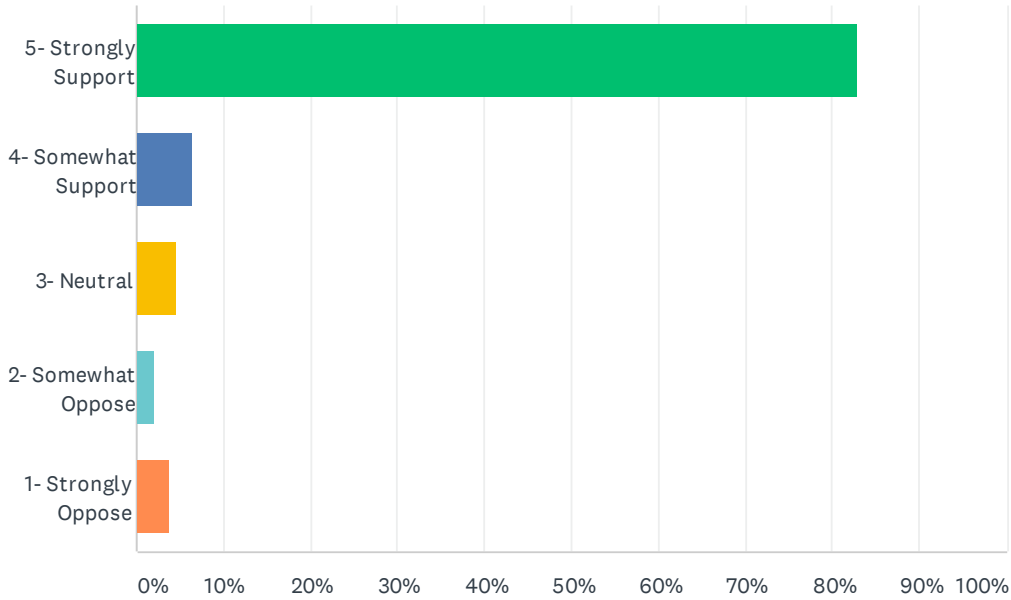

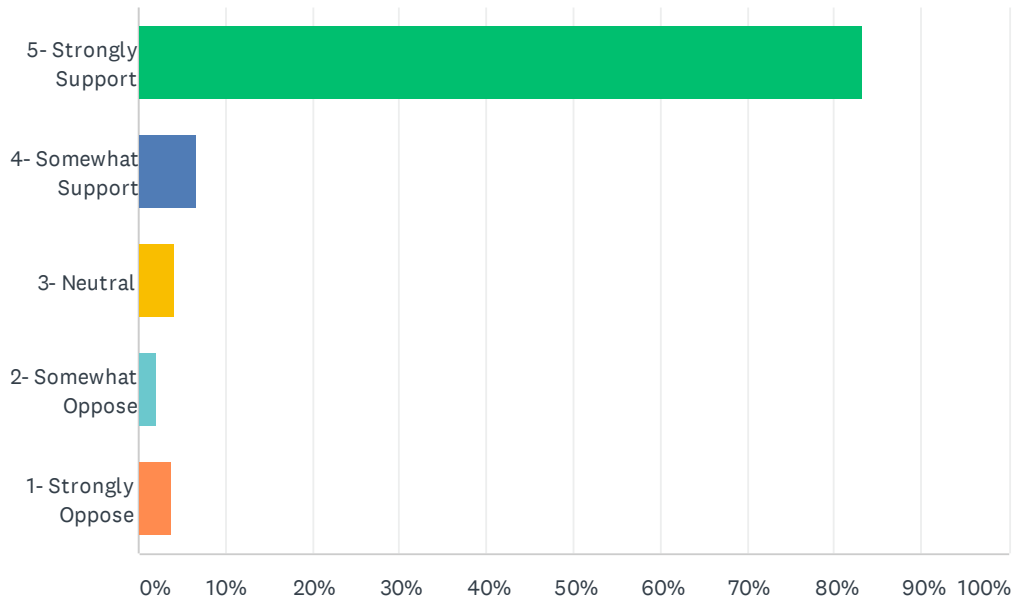

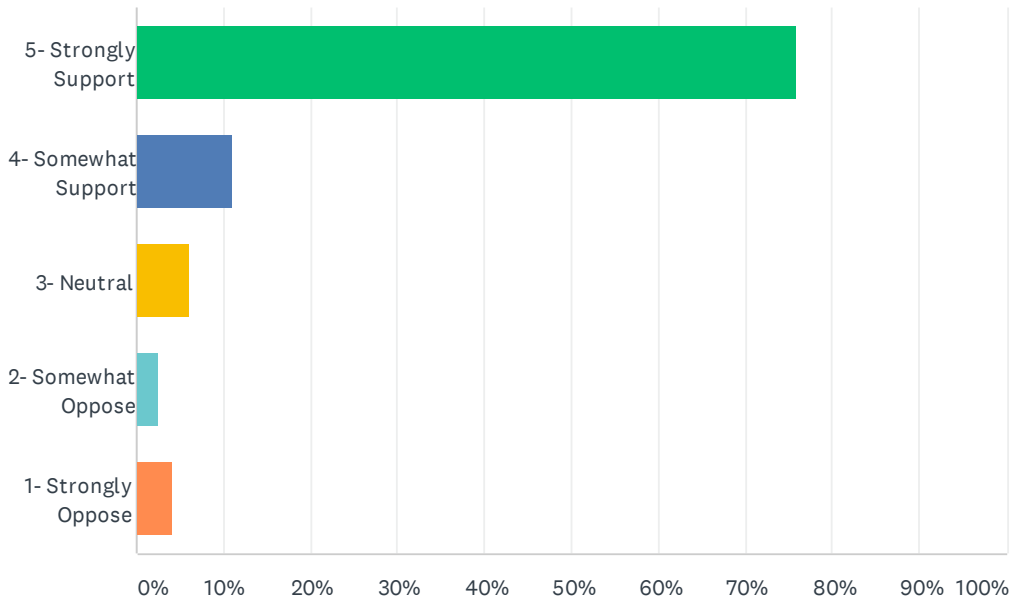

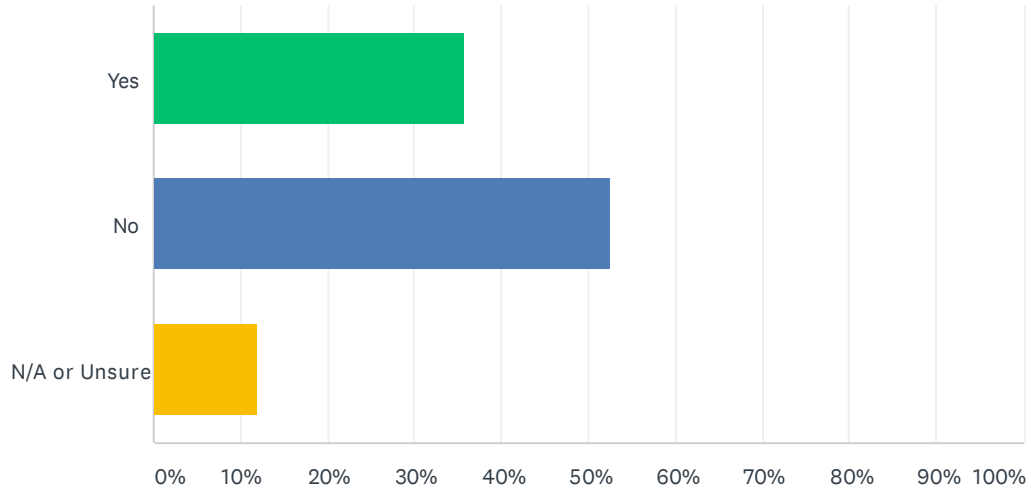

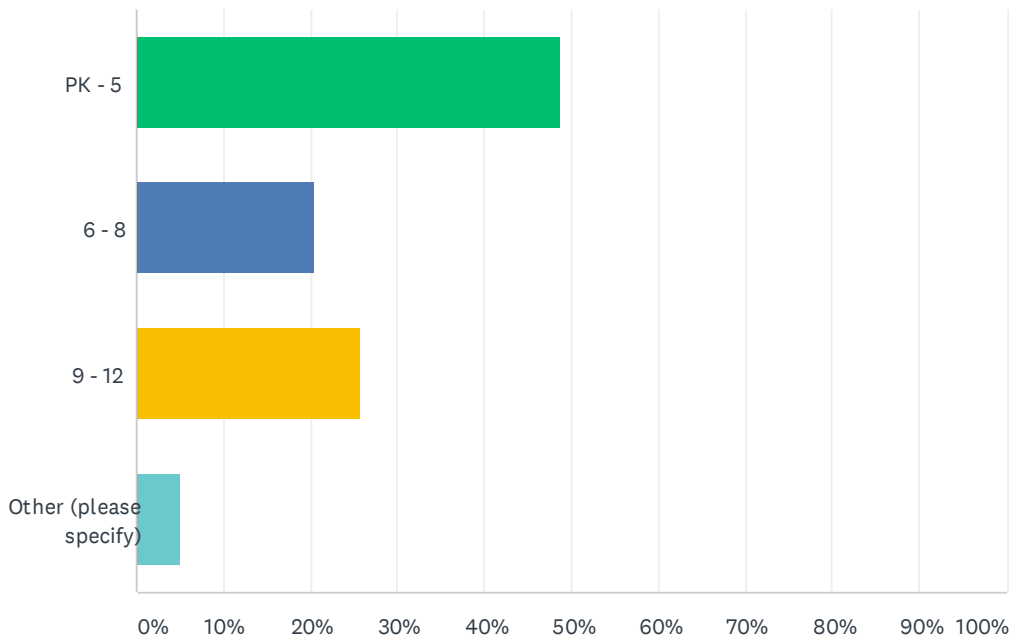

Q35 With which grades do you mostly work?

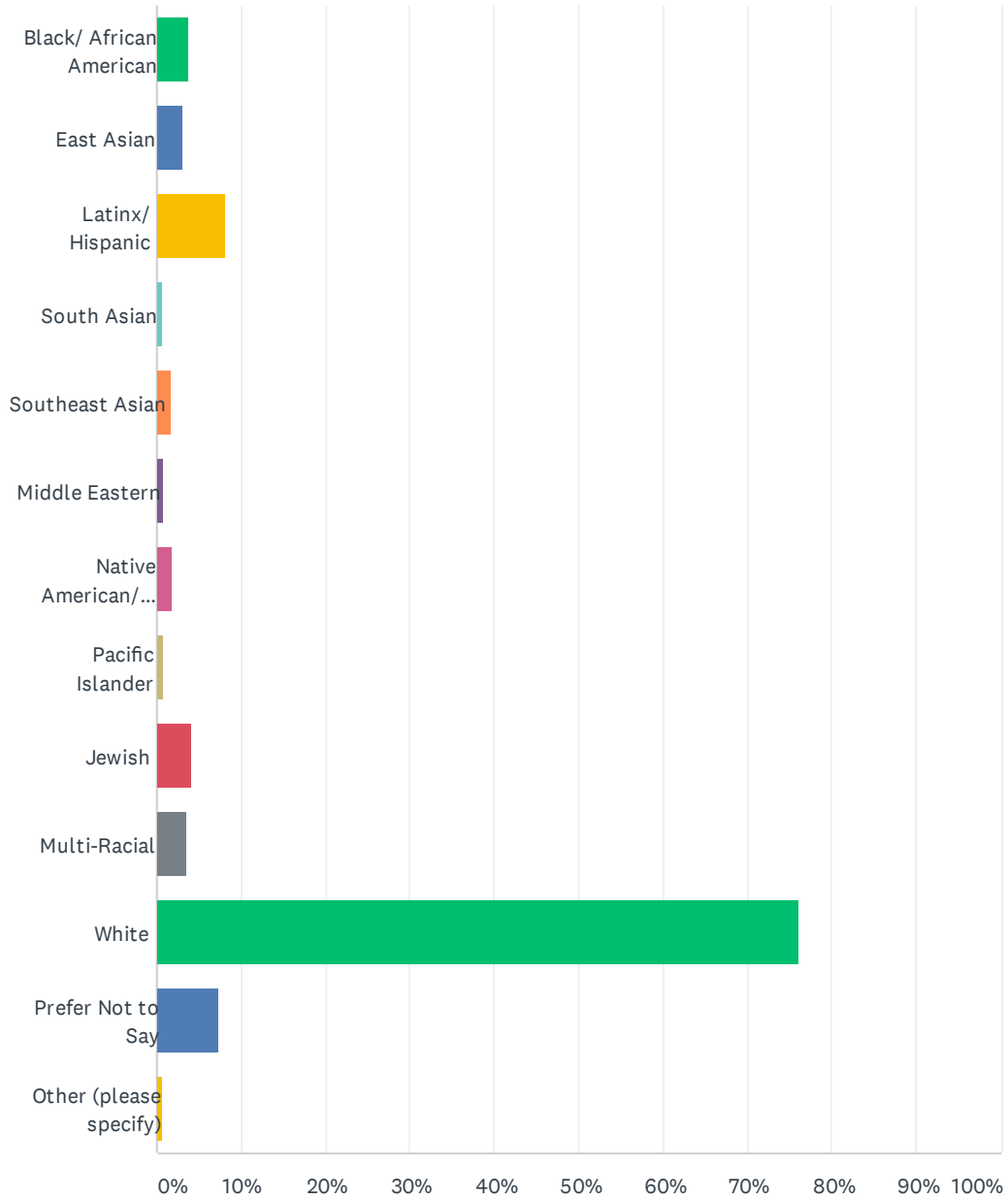

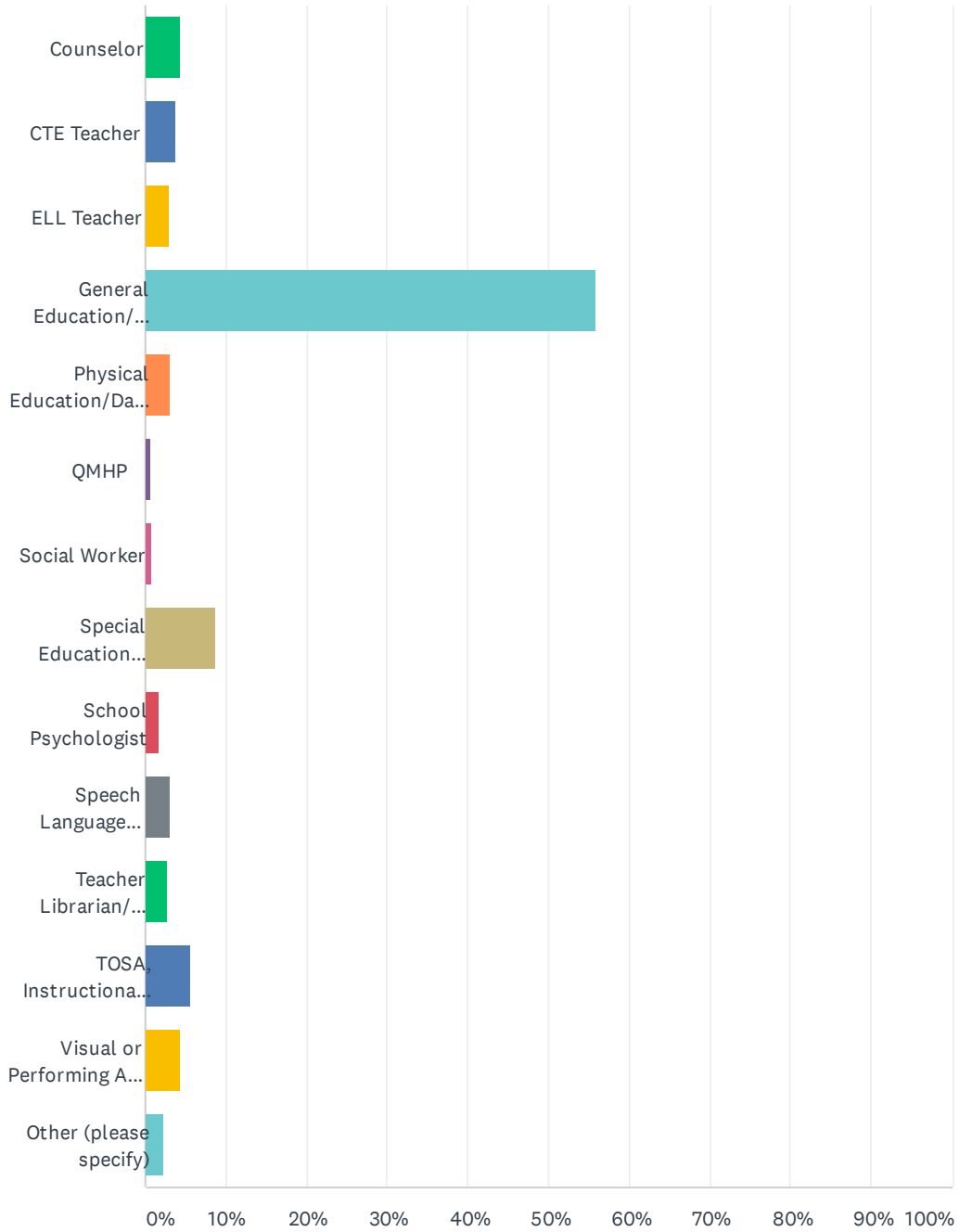
