- A well-rounded education to encourage creativity, with art, PE, and music
- Resources allocated to classroom instruction, not new central office positions
- Educators allowed to exercise professional judgment, plan their lessons, and collaborate with members of the school community

Be a voice in running your union.

- Participate in decision-making for the Portland Association of Teachers and its state (OEA) and national (NEA) organizations
- Elect union leaders, run for union office
- Become a member of PAT, OEA and NEA committees
- Make key decisions to improve working conditions in your school

Enjoy Protection as an Individual.

- \$1 million educators’ liability policy for civil claims related to employment
- Reimbursement of attorneys’ fees in successful defense of criminal charges related to employment

Work together for children and education.

- Improve learning conditions and wrap-around supports for our students
- Insure that each educator has the resources, mentoring and support every professional needs

Bargain a strong contract.

- Bargain working conditions that attract and retain quality educators
- Bargain contract provisions that guarantee a respectful working environment with just cause and due process protections

Advocate for Social Justice.

- Promote equity of opportunity for all students, regardless of their zip code
- Engage with members of other unions to work on social, economic and civil rights justice issues

- Collective strength means power to gain improvements in salary, benefits and working conditions through collective bargaining
- Greater buying power, providing for members-only benefits such as service and merchandise discounts for auto and insurance, travel, credit cards, etc.
