

## **Vote re Furlough/ Work Share Plan**

### **Result of Yes Vote:**

- PPS will preserve resources for the 2020-2021 academic year and reduce the number of negatively impacted employees in the bargaining unit.
- PAT members will be furloughed one day per week (Fridays). There will be no expectations of work on Fridays. PAT members will have their PPS paycheck reduced by 20%.
- In addition to the PPS payroll check, PAT members will receive two additional paychecks each week, one from Unemployment, and one from CARES.
- PPS will be responsible for submitting names of all PAT members to the Oregon Unemployment office.
- PAT members will be responsible for filling out one form, one time only.
- Some PAT members will not be eligible; those PAT members will not be furloughed and will continue to receive their regular paychecks.
- PAT members are not required to submit the Unemployment application, however, they can not opt out of the furlough. PAT members can have their schedule reduced and not receive additional pay through the CARES act (the \$600) or Unemployment.

### **Result of No Vote:**

- There will be no modification to the 2019-2020 calendar.
- You will not be required to take one day off per week (Fridays). You will continue to work your 5 day work week.
- There will be no modification to pay.
- PPS will not save money.
