

OEA REPORT CARD FIVE-STAR SYSTEM EXPLAINED

In assessing the policy work of any legislature, organizations and individuals typically turn to voting records to determine public officials' performance. The problems with over-reliance on this data source are several: in Oregon, much of the work on bills is done at the committee level. Once a bill makes it to the House or Senate chamber for a "floor vote", all the difficult issues have been resolved, or else the bill does not get a vote. Also, record votes are sometimes changed for procedural reasons, rather than for support or opposition to underlying policies. Finally, in an increasingly transactional legislative environment, the fate of some bills is tied to the fate of other, unrelated legislation, so votes may reflect less about the bill than about the climate.

For this reason, the OEA is introducing a new aspect to the report card that takes into consideration a range of important factors in assessing the overall public education support of Oregon's 90 legislators. While the voting record is a starting point for consideration, other criteria, described below, also influence our assessment. This system uses a five-star rating to incorporate all qualities of legislative performance in 2017.

CRITERIA



A strong voting record* on OEA priority bills
Sponsorship or co-sponsorship of OEA legislation
Leadership on public education issues, aligned with OEA positions
Seeks OEA staff and member input, involvement
Advocates for educators in committees, caucus, etc.
Is a trusted, communicative ally of OEA staff and members



A strong voting record* on OEA priority bills
Advocates for OEA members, legislation in committee/on floor
Communicates with and provides access to staff and/or members



A mixed voting record* on OEA priority bills
Occasionally a positive voice for public education



A mixed voting record* on OEA priority bills
Occasionally a positive voice for public education



A disappointing voting record* on OEA priority bills
May take actions against public education, OEA members, staff

**Voting record may be mitigated upward or downward by other activities and performance characteristics.*
