Calling all high school Climate Justice educators! The plan for Climate Change and Climate Justice Curriculum Integration calls for the development of a high school elective course that can be piloted in the coming school year (2020-2021).

This innovative, transdisciplinary course will offer students an opportunity to explore the root causes of climate change, with a focus on the human impacts on our environment, and collaborate to design solutions to climate-related problems.

We are seeking one design team per high school, including alternative sites. Each team should be comprised of one **social studies educator**, one **science educator**, plus 3-5 **students**, with the option to add an additional educator who specializes in ESL and/or special education. Students and educators will be compensated.
