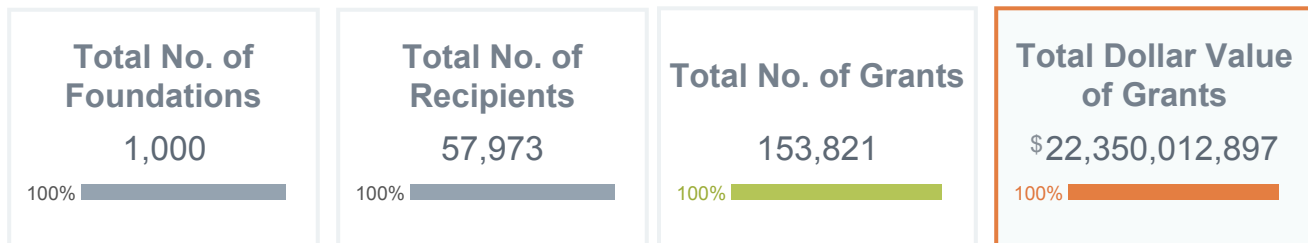

























Distribution of Grants from FC 1000 Foundations by Subject Area, 2012







Distribution of Grants from FC 1000 Foundations by Recipient Location, 2012





