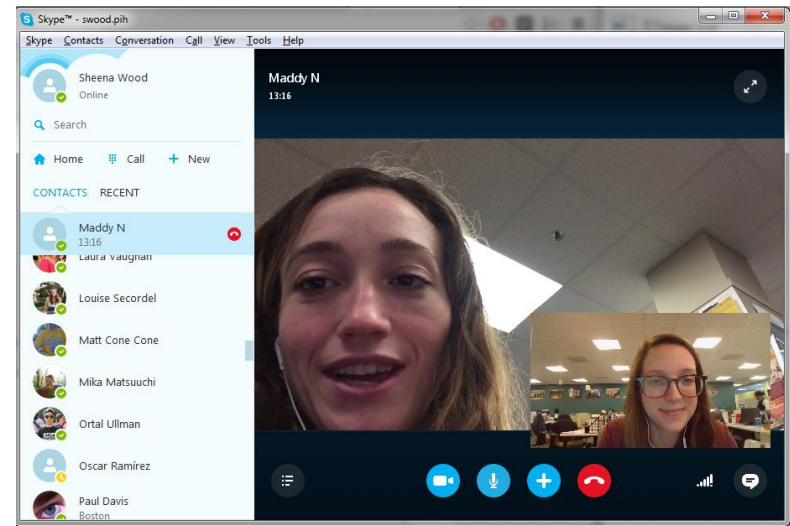

Coaching

- Your main point of contact
- Expect:
 - Scheduled Skype calls (as often as 2x per month)
 - Emails
 - Webinars

Expectations for Team Coordinators

- Set a consistent time and day for coaching calls
- Be present on calls!
- Give notice if you have to reschedule (and reschedule ASAP)
- Check in regularly with leads



- Join lead-position specific group calls
- Check (and read!) emails
- Use online resources
- Be an ambassador for your teammates
- Ask questions
