We are writing to make a request for information under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for all records relating to the use of a cell site simulator, or IMSI-catcher, commonly referred to as a StingRay or KingFish ("the device"). The Stingray is a common

It was recently reported that police departments in the United States have begun using the device to surreptitiously capture text messages, calls, emails and other data from cell phones.

Specifically, we are seeking the following:

- 1. Any documents or communications indicating whether the Vancouver Police Department (VPD) has either:
 - a. discussed purchasing this device;
 - b. has purchased this device;
 - c. or, is currently using this device.
- 2. If the device has been purchased, or negotiations were entered into for the potential purchase of this device, we would like a copy of the contract with the vendor.
- 3. Any policy documents or communications indicating whether or not the department has any intention to purchase this device or use it in the future in Vancouver.


Please limit the date search from January 1st, 2010 to the present date.
