Accomplishments

August 2020:

Dr Coker held a meeting with Christian leaders and pastors in the city of Bo where he has a church branch that he oversees. The meeting took a resolution to elect PJTN coordinators who would align to the mission of PJTN to pray for and speak on behalf of Israel as well as for the president of PJTN.

The meeting was followed by two radio interviews on Harvest and Star Christian radio stations.

September 2020:

Dr Coker held meetings in the Kenema district, with pastors and members of the Israel Prayer Network (IPN) where he explained his role in PJTN and why it is important for Sierra Leone and invited volunteers to serve as PJTN coordinators.

The meetings in this district were also followed by two radio interviews on SLBC and 98.1 which drew great responses from the audiences.

Dr Coker met with former member of parliament who has visited Israel and shared his insights and is willing to work with him.

On the 25th September Dr Coker attended the Parliamentary Israel Prayer Fellowship to pray for Sierra Leone's president and that the embassy would be moved to Jerusalem.

Dr Coker is working on registering PJTN as a NPO in Sierra Leone.

Despite the challenge of finances for these activities, Dr Coker trusts that God will make a way for him to accomplish the work he has committed to.
