



# OUTSTANDING IDEAS GRANTS PROGRAM

## FAST APPLICATION

PROF's **Outstanding Ideas Grants Program** helps fund innovative projects dreamed up by Pine-Richland teachers and staff to enrich the educational experiences of their students either inside or outside of the classroom.

The **FAST APPLICATION** serves to streamline the grant request and approval processes for applicants. If a grant request is **\$1,000 or less**, PROF will consider a *FAST* application to evaluate and respond quickly. The grant will be evaluated similarly to the full grant application, but will focus primarily on the following criteria:

<b>FAST Grant Evaluation Rubric</b>	
<b>Student Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides clear evidence of enriching the curriculum</li> </ul>
<b>Innovation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Demonstrates engaging, creative and new pathways to learning beyond the traditional curriculum</li> </ul>
<b>Strategic Alignment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Aligns with PROF's <a href="#">objectives</a></li> <li>Aligns with PRSD's curriculum initiatives and mission to focus on learning for every student every day.</li> </ul>

### Grant Application Instructions

1. Develop a project summary and obtain required signatures (Section 1).

- Section 2: Budget Breakdown
