RE: Request for Access to Information

I writing in response to your request for access to information under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act) received by the Lethbridge Police Service October 17, 2016. The Lethbridge Police Service is pleased to inform you that your request for general statistical information associated to individuals being stopped and requested to provide identification or to identify themselves from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2016 has been granted. As per your request a blank Street Check form and copy of the Lethbridge Police Services policy on Street Checks accompanies this correspondence. Additionally, a series of tables are enclosed detailing the requested information pertaining to Street Checks conducted by the Lethbridge Police Service. To ensure the provided statistical information remains de-identified and that no unreasonable invasion of third party personal information occurs, all provided information is itemized either over a monthly or yearly time period.

During the requested time period of January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2016 the Lethbridge Police Service conducted a total of 1062 Street Checks. In the event multiple officers or multiple individuals were involved in a singular Street Check occurrence, the Street Check occurrence was documented more than once within the respective statistical table(s).

Section 65 of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act provides that you may make a written request to the Information and Privacy Commissioner to review this matter. You have 60 days from the date of this notice to request a review by writing to the Commissioner at 410, 9925-109 Street, Edmonton, Alberta, T5K 2J8

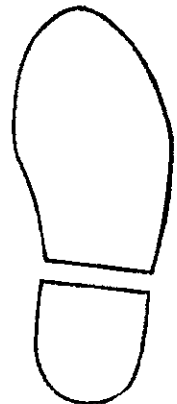
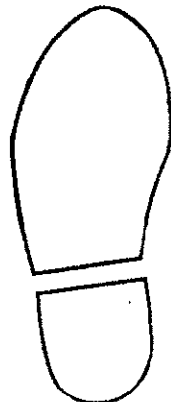

6. Field Interviews and Street Information/Check Reports:

As outlined in the Introduction to Part 2, General Investigations, it is the responsibility of all personnel to assist in the gathering and processing of criminal intelligence. The major components of this process are:

a. Field Interviews:

Should be conducted with individuals who are seen under suspicious circumstances and the nature of their actions and presence in the area raises the possibility of criminal activity:

- i) persons who are known to be involved in criminal activity,
- ii) persons who may be able to supply information about criminal activities, or
- iii) persons checked during an investigation as a matter of course and who are believed involved in criminal activity.

b. Street Information/Check Report:

It is important that records of field interviews be maintained so that persons involved in crime or who have knowledge of criminal activity may be monitored. Persons checked under suspicious circumstances should also be recorded in the event that they are linked to criminal activity.

The recording of intelligence gathered through a field interview shall be in one of two ways

- i) by way of direct entry into Niche RMS as a Street Check Report; or
- ii) completion of a Street Information Report.

Additionally, if the person checked is of particular interest to a specific section, a report will be submitted outlining all of the particulars and a file number will be assigned the report. The report will then be directed to the respective section.

Non-Responsive

The Street Information/Check Reports contain description fields for information about one person: physical features, past record, vehicle, associates, and additional comments.

Members have the ability to either enter Street Check Reports directly into the NICHE system or on completion of a shift members can submit hand written Street Information Reports directly to their Staff Sergeant.

Staff Sergeants, upon receiving hand written Street Information reports, shall have them entered into NICHE as Street Check Reports by the RMU civilian support staff as soon as possible.
